



Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

This morning you play a very important part of our worship service as you process in with palm branches. I will be processing with you as will the choir. It is a joyous display of God's love for sending His Son to die for us.

You will wave palm branches because that is what the people of God did when Jesus came in on the donkey's colt. The palm branches are emblems of praise and victory! And you are saying, I wave this before Jesus because He is my King!!

The congregation will be singing praises to God as we process into the sanctuary. All of it says to all of us: Jesus reigns as King over all!!

You should thank God right now that you understand these things. Many people have never heard the story of Jesus' Triumphal Entry, and many times, those who have heard it, do not understand it. Even when Jesus came into Jerusalem that day most of the people did not understand truly what was going on. I'll be preaching on a lot of that this morning.

Here are some questions you can answer while I am preaching:


- 1. How many people came to Jerusalem for Passover that year? _____
- 2. When the crowd said, "Hosanna!" what did they mean?
- 3. On what was Jesus riding?
- 4. Obviously, the religious leaders did not understand the significance of the day. Who did they religious leaders want to kill? (There were two.)
- 5. Obviously, the crowd did not understand the meaning of the day. What did they expect from Jesus now? What did they want from Him? Or, what did they want to make Him right then and there?
- 6. Even the disciples didn't get it. Why couldn't they understand? They needed help from Whom?

Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you: the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



Child Evangelism Fellowship (CEF) is a worldwide organization dedicated to seeing every child reached with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus, and then discipled and established in a local church.

One of their best-known ministries is called Good News Club. These clubs meet in public schools after regular classes. Twenty of these clubs are in Central Alabama. Trinity Church sponsors a Club at Forest Avenue Elementary Magnet School. Each week the volunteers from Trinity Church present an exciting Bible lesson, songs, Scripture memory, a missions story and fun games. The Club is like Sunday School except that it is on Tuesday afternoon.

Music and Hymns

#455 "And Can it Be that I Should Gain"

This hymn is very poetic and beautiful. The writer speaks of the wonder and mystery of Christ's death for our sins. Verse 4 says "long my imprisoned spirit lay fast bound in sin and nature's night...I woke, the dungeon flamed with light; my chains fell off." This is a wonderful picture of how we are imprisoned by our sins, but Jesus' death and resurrection saved us and covered our sin with His light, releasing us from the chains of sin. We are now free in His salvation!

#235 "All Glory, Laud and Honor"

We sing this every Palm Sunday because it mentions the children crying out "hosanna" as they waved their palms at His passing through the gates of Jerusalem on a donkey. Hosanna can be translated as "please save" or "save now." Did you know the word "laud" means "praise"? Zechariah prophesied about Jesus riding on a donkey in Zechariah 9:9 which states: "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion Shout aloud, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is He, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey."
