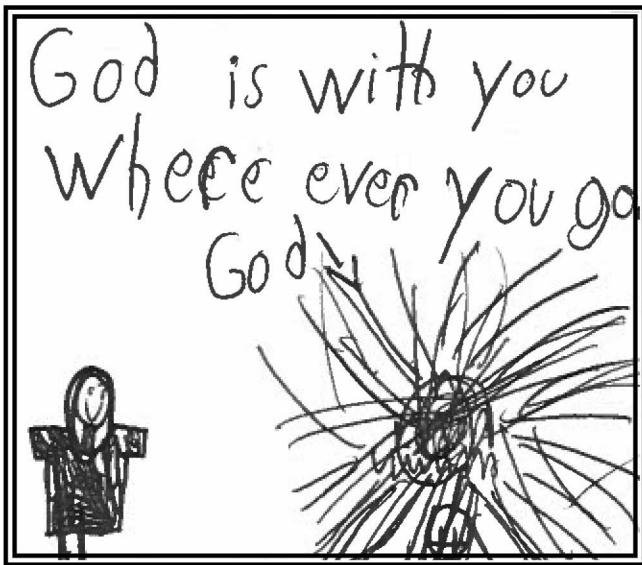


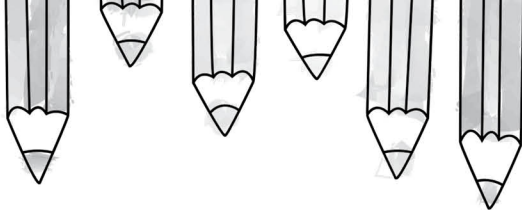

Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

I can't believe it's time for Vacation Bible School again!! This year has flown by. I will look so forward to seeing you in the morning, Lord willing. I hope to see you at the opening session when we find out which all of our friends will be there, what songs we will sing, what the skit will be about, what the memory verses will be, and just how fun the week is going to be!

VBS is such a great week to come learn about Jesus in the summer mornings for five days. Many, many people will tell you that they actually gave their lives to Jesus at a VBS. Many others will tell you it was at VBS that they learned how important Scripture memory is.

When I was your age, I went to VBS. I went in Jackson, MS, and we learned a lot of catechism questions. VBS was a time you could say your memory work for Sunday School and recite the catechism. And I can remember being about 7 or 8 years old, and sitting with a few friends and a teacher in a stairwell learning the catechism. When I look back now – almost 50 years later! – I am so thankful for VBS!!

This morning in worship we will pray for VBS. We will also learn more about the life of David. And in particular, we will see David on the run, scared, and even lying to get out of trouble. But we also see David run to God for help and strength. He sees God as our Refuge – Someone we can always run to in times of trouble.

Talk about some of the questions provided below with your mom and dad, and try to apply what I preach on this morning to your life.

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use This Week

- 1. Ask your children: have you ever been scared? Do you know what fear is? Do think God knew when you were afraid? Is He someone you could call on in times of fear?**
- 2. Read all of Psalm 56 and 34 over the course of the week. Learn to pray the Psalms. Take one verse and pray it in your own words.**
- 3. What does this mean to you: "Jesus is my Shepherd?"**
- 4. What did you learn at VBS today? Did you make new friends? Who is your teacher?**
- 5. Ask your child: how can I pray for you? Then let them hear you pray for them.**

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!!
10 EASY STEPS

- #1** Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- #2** Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- #3** It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- #4** Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- #5** Sing a song or two together.
- #6** Take prayer requests.

- #8** Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9** Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- #10** Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26



Meet Our Missionaries!



Jim & Mary Alice Patterson Serving with **Mission to the World & Wycliffe Bible Translators**

The Pattersons have served the Lord for many years and lived in Colombia, South America, then in the Philippine Islands near Asia and then several other South Asian countries. In all those places, they were part of a team of people who translated the Bible into languages that don't have the Bible yet. Jim supervised other people who kept the buildings, roads, and vehicles in good condition. They also maintained the electric, water, and communications technology. In South Asia, they made audio recordings of someone reading parts of the Bible. They also made recordings of Bible stories like we tell in Sunday School with different people playing the part of each person in those stories. One of those stories was about Joseph in Egypt, and how God provided for him. The recordings are for people who cannot read or do not have the Bible in a written language. Recently, the Pattersons moved to North Carolina to work with the Wycliffe Bible Translators Jungle Aviation and Radio Service Center. Mary Alice continues working with audio recordings while Jim does building maintenance. The Pattersons help us understand how God uses people with many different job skills and abilities to help tell people around the world about Jesus. How could you do that someday?
