





# Just a word from Mr. Tom

Dear Children,

The Bible is the most important book that we have. Mr. Mac calls it “the very mind of God in print.” We often call it “The Word of Life” because it tells us about Jesus so we will put our faith in Him and live eternally with Him. Most of our homes have several Bibles and many of you have your own Bible.

Can you imagine how it would be if we didn’t have a Bible? How could your parents or Sunday School teacher or Mr. Mac know what to teach about God? There are many places in the world with no Bible, because it hasn’t been translated into their language. There are even places where the people don’t have a written language.

Trinity Church committed money and our prayers to help translate the Bible for the “Rujak” people. They are a population of more than 500,000 people who live in Asia. The people who are doing this translation work moved to where the Rujak people live, with their families, so they can learn that language, and translate the Bible into that language. They do not have churches, because no people there know Jesus, except for the Bible translation team. Their families don’t get to enjoy some of the things we do, but they are willing to make that sacrifice so God’s Word will be available for the Rujak people.

Five people from Trinity Church are leaving Montgomery this week to get to know some of the Rujak people and to help the people who are doing the translation work. It will take over 3 days to travel the 10,000 miles from Montgomery to get to where the Rujak people live. Our team from Trinity Church are not translators, but they will help teach English to some of the Rujak people so the Bible translation team will have more people from that language to work with them.

Will you please ask God to bless this Bible translation team with these prayer requests?


- Pray for the translation team and their work to give the Rujak people a Bible in their own language.
- Pray for the Rujak people to trust Jesus for their salvation and to start churches where God may be worshipped.
- Pray for our Trinity Church team to have good travel, make friends with the Rujak people, and help the translation team.

## Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use This Week

1. Talk to your children about how important the Bible is for us to know God, and how we use it in all our worship services at Trinity. Show them where you keep Bibles in your home and how you read it personally.

**THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!!**  
**10 EASY STEPS**

- #1** Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- #2** Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- #3** It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- #4** Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- #5** Sing a song or two together.
- #6** Take prayer requests.
- #7** Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
- #8** Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9** Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- #10** Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26





**Meet Our Missionaries!**



**Trinity's Rujak  
Missions Trip Team  
Serving in Asia**

This week's missionaries are normally here with us every Sunday, except this week and next week they will be on the other side of the world doing a missions trip. They will be working with several people there who are translating the Bible into another language. Our team will teach some of the people from that town about English language, and they will help the translation team identify some people who could help them with the Bible translation work.

The team members will be commissioned during the evening service on Sunday, July 14 so you will have an opportunity to see them and hear more about their trip.

The team will leave Montgomery on Wednesday, July 17 and fly to an Asian country. It will take about three days of travel by air and then by van to get to their destination on Saturday. They will return on Monday, July 29. Please pray for good travel, effective work with the translation team and for our team to learn the lessons God wants them to learn.

# Music and Hymns

## **#455 "And Can it Be that I Should Gain"**

**This hymn is very poetic and beautiful. The writer speaks of the wonder and mystery of Christ's death for our sins. Verse 4 says "long my imprisoned spirit lay fast bound in sin and nature's night...I woke, the dungeon flamed with light; my chains fell off." This is a wonderful picture of how we are imprisoned by our sins, but Jesus' death and resurrection saved us and covered our sin with His light, releasing us from the chains of sin. We are now free in His salvation!**

## **#164 "O For a Thousand Tongues to Sing"**

**This hymn is about praising our Lord for the many things He does for us, such as taking away our sins, sorrows, and fears. Charles Wesley wrote this hymn in the 1700's after a bout of illness made him doubt God. He began to read the Bible and the words gave him peace and his faith was restored. Charles wrote this hymn eleven years after his conversion and he recommended it as a hymn for others to sing on the anniversaries of their conversions. Have you ever thought of celebrating the anniversary of your salvation; the anniversary of giving your life to Christ? What song would you choose to praise Him on your conversion anniversary?**
