


Is there something that has made you a better Christian? Or, a better way to say that is, something that has made you think more about Jesus and His love for you and your walk with Him?

If I could choose a few things, I would include: (1) the importance of good, godly friendships; (2) the love of God, especially the word for the love of the Old Testament, hesed; (3) the way God works in our lives behind the scenes – the things we can't see Him doing; and, (4) this study helped me see how David points us to Jesus, the true King Who will reign forever and ever.



Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use This Week

- 1. Parents, why don't you look above and answer those questions for yourself and with your children? What HAVE you learned in this series in David's life? How can you help your children apply David's life (and David's Savior) to them and their lives?
- 2. Can you recall a few of the many times we have seen David rescued by God? Read through II Samuel 22 or Psalm 18 and give your children hope that God will deliver them no matter what their situation.
- 3. We have looked at hesed five times in our study: God's unconditional, never-changing love; infinite mercy! What does that mean to you? Tell your children.
- 4. At the end of Mr. Mac's sermon, the question was asked: Who is Jesus? How would you answer that? Tell you children. (Ask them first.)
- 5. We sang some great hymns today; can you sing them together as a family?

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. #1 #2 Try really hard to make the same time every day. #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 #5 Sing a song or two together. #6 Take prayer requests. #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you: the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



Faith Radio Montgomery, AL

Faith Radio began transmitting at 89.1 FM in 1984. The call letters, WLBF, were chosen, standing for "We Live By Faith". Today, they broadcast from Alexander City at 94.1, Brewton at 92.1, Eufaula at 91.9, Sylacauga at 94.1, Thorsby/Jemison at 96.9, in Haiti from 94.7FM, on channel 104 in Baptist Health hospitals in Montgomery and Prattville, on channel 82 at East Alabama Medical Center in Opelika, and by Faith Radio app, available for download on iPhone, iPad, and Android devices. Faith Radio's mission is to serve the Christian Community and strengthen the local church and family unit by providing spiritual encouragement and a personal challenge with a Christ centered focus, through Biblical teaching, relevant information and uplifting music to the Glory of God.

#252 "When I Survey the Wondrous Cross"

Do you ever stop to take a close look at the cross and what it meant for Jesus to have to die for your very own sins? Many people don't like to think about the price Christ had to pay because those thoughts are just too painful. We might not be murderers or thieves, but we all have pride in our hearts. "Sorrow and love flow mingled down" means that as He was dying for us, He had the mixed emotions of love and sorrow at the same time. In the 4th verse, we see where Isaac Watts, the hymn writer, concludes that "love so amazing and divine demands our soul, our life, OUR ALL!

The Power of the Cross

Have you ever thought about "every bitter thought and every evil deed" being in that crown of thorns that pierced Jesus' head as he hung on the cross? Have you ever thought about your own name being "written in [His] wounds?" It is almost too much to bear, but that is exactly what the Bible says! Peter 2:24 says "He Himself bore our sins in His body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By His wounds you have been healed." Isaiah 49:16 says that our names are written in His hands and John 10:28-29 says that no one can snatch us out of Jesus' hands or The Father's hands. We are safe in His hands and we are free by the power of the cross and the blood that was shed for your salvation.
