







Meet Our Missionaries!



Jonah & Jennifer Frontiers, Nineveh

Jonah and Jennifer live in and minister within a nation that is 99% Muslim so we don't identify their real names or actual location. Their country is ranked by some Christian organizations within the top 5 of all nations for extreme religious persecution against Christians. Radical Islamic factions present the most visible threat, but the most common sources of danger for converts are their own families, since conversion from Islam is seen as cause for shame or even blasphemy. In spite of this hostility, the church exists there and even meets regularly and openly in some places while more covertly in others. Jonah fills preaching, teaching and discipleship roles and travels frequently to meet with churches and groups of believers. Trinity Church began supporting Jonah and Jennifer in 1991.

Will you pray for them?

- Pray for Jonah as he pastors fellow believers during this time of celebrating the birth of the Light of the World with His message of hope and life in their spiritually very dark nation.
- Pray for flexibility and wisdom with great instability and uncertainty in their country so they will fix their eyes on the Lord to maintain long-term goals while also dealing with short-term plans.
- Pray for ongoing Bible study groups, and other means of discipleship to bring theological and spiritual maturity for church leaders and members.
- Pray for good health and spiritual protection for Jonah and Jennifer while they continue serving Christ's Kingdom.

#196 "Come, Thou Long-Expected Jesus"

This is a hymn about the joy and expectation of Jesus' birth and the joy and expectation of His second coming! Verse 4 says "Born Thy people to deliver, born a child and yet a king, born to reign in us forever, now Thy gracious kingdom bring." Jesus' birth was prophesied hundreds of years before He was born. The Jews were anticipating a Messiah to be born of a virgin and that is exactly what happened. Now, 2000 years after His death, we await His second coming where we will get to see Him face to face. Isn't that exciting? Praise Him for his birth, praise Him for his death, praise Him for his resurrection, and praise Him that He is coming again!
