Meet Our Missionaries!



Greg & Julieann Global Serve International

Greg and Julieann went to Siberia with two young sons in 1994 to work among the Buriat ethnic population, an Unreached People Group in that remote, frozen land. They established a church plant that has grown over the years into a network of churches. Later, Greg became part of the leadership team that established Global Serve International which strategically focuses on other unreached people groups across the Asian region in places that are not open to normal missions efforts. Their multidisciplinary teams of two or three couples and single Christ followers who work in each location bring business development, medical, educational and linguistic skills to bear with the long term intent of evangelizing, discipling, Bible translation and church planting. The ultimate goal in each location is to establish a locally lead, self-sustaining church movement that will bear witness to the Gospel within that culture.

Trinity Church began supporting Greg & Julieann in 1999. In 2017, we committed support for the first five years of the Rujak Bible Translation Project which is being done by one of their multidisciplinary Global Serve teams.

Music and Hymns

#211 "God Rest You Merry, Gentlemen"

The first verse reminds us as Christians not to feel hopeless and worry about things, for Christ was born to save us from Satan's power! The rest of the hymn tells the Christmas story of the angel appearing to the shepherds in the field, telling them not to fear, and the shepherd's response; that is, they immediately went to Bethlehem to see and to worship Jesus. We need to be like those shepherds at Christmas---in bold confidence approaching Christ to worship and adore Him. "Tidings of comfort and joy" means "good news to comfort us and give us much to be joyful about!"

#164 "O, for a Thousand Tongues to Sing"

This hymn is about praising our Lord for the many things He does for us, such as taking away our sins, sorrows, and fears. Charles Wesley wrote this hymn in the 1700's after a bout of illness made him doubt God. He began to read the Bible and the words gave him peace and his faith was restored. Charles wrote this hymn eleven years after his conversion and he recommended it as a hymn for others to sing on the anniversaries of their conversions. Have you ever thought of celebrating the anniversary of your salvation; the anniversary of giving your life to Christ? What song would you choose to praise Him on your conversion anniversary?
