

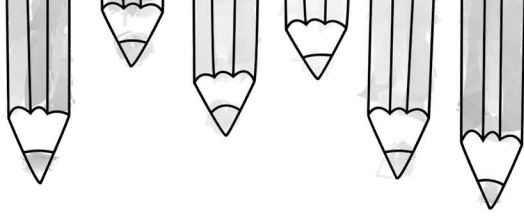

Just a word from Mr. Mac

I want you to look up the meaning of your name this week. Ask your mom and dad to help you find the meaning of your name. Ask them to tell you why they gave you your name.

Talk about this with your mom and dad because this is a very special thing between you and them. They chose your name for a reason and because they love you so much.

I am named for my dad, and I am the third ~ Claude Eugene McRoberts III.

I hope my mom and dad did not name me by the meaning of the name because my name means: Lame Birth. That's not a very encouraging name.

But when I looked it up in a book with Christian meaning behind the name, I read where my name means: afflicted so that God can use you. I like that a whole lot more.

When my son (who also has my name) was your age, I told him that his name meant lame birth but that it also meant afflicted so that God can use you. I wasn't even sure he heard me or was old enough to understand. Then about 2 years later, out of nowhere, he said to me, "My name means God is going to use me."

Names are important. And Jesus' name is no different. In fact, HIS name means more than anyone else's name. The reason is because God named Him, and His name not only fulfills prophecies but it tells us Who He is and why He came to this earth.

Jesus means, The Lord Saves or God Saves or The Lord is My Salvation. Jesus came to save sinners from their sins. He came to make a way possible for you and me to have a place in heaven with Him and our heavenly Father forever and ever.

10 EASY STEPS

Carlos and Erin Gutierrez **Isaiah 55** **Reynosa, Mexico**

In 2004, Trinity Church members Kate & NoNo Beale established Isaiah 55 Ministries in the border city of Reynosa, Mexico with a population of a million people. The ministry works among the deaf and marginalized to make disciples, encourage the worship of Jesus, and promote justice and reconciliation. The deaf education programs span from K-12 with follow up vocational training to prepare students for manufacturing jobs. The neighborhood outreach includes a wide array of educational, recreational and spiritual programs for those in the impoverished community surrounding the mission facility.

Carlos was born in Mexico City. His family moved to Ciudad Victoria, Mexico, to start a Christian school, Renuevo. Although he has an MBA in Business Administration, he spent several years working at Renuevo as well as within the University system. One of his great passions is to teach all school subjects with a Christian perspective and also to train teachers to do the same, which is what he does at a school for the Deaf in Reynosa, Mexico. He is also working on developing the curriculum with a Christian worldview.

Erin comes from a big family and a big farm in Iowa. Erin was saved at age 17 and has been following Jesus on a journey ever since. After studying English and Spanish at Eureka College, she moved to Mexico in 2003. Erin's job at Isaiah 55 is to coordinate with government, local non-profits, and the Church for the progress of the deaf students and vast community surrounding them.

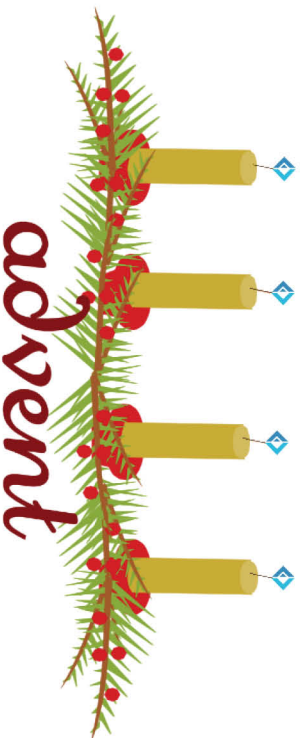
