




Dear Children.

The first Lord's Day of the New Year: 2020!!! Don't you love the first Sunday of a new year?! It all seems so new and exciting!

Some people make *New Year's Resolutions*. I do it. I like doing it. Most of the time it's just things I've tried to do in the last year ... or last January. But having disciplines and having a new commitment to them is a good thing.

14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.



THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.

#2 Try really hard to make the same time every day. #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 #5 Sing a song or two together. #6 Take prayer requests. #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you: the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



#598 "Guide Me, O Thou Great Jehovah"

The Lord Guides us. He is our "Bread of heaven," our "Strong Deliverer," and our "Strength and Shield." If we seek Him He will feed us spiritually, He will protect us, and He will deliver us from evil. He will guide us down the path of life. Matthew7:14 says "For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it." Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life. Trust in Him and ask Him to guide you!

#296 "All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name"

Philippians 2:9 says that Jesus' name is above every other name. There are places in the Bible where people were healed simply by having faith in Jesus. We pray in His name because there is power in His name. We are baptized in His name. Demons have been cast out in His name. In the Christmas story, the book of Matthew quotes the prophet Isaiah in saying "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son and they shall call His name Immanuel." Immanuel means "God with us." Jesus, which is Yeshua in its original Hebrew form, means "He will save or the Lord saves." Jesus was a fairly common name when Jesus was born, but He was and is the only one who is "God with us" and it is only by His name that we are saved!
