




THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. #1 #2 Try really hard to make the same time every day. #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 #5 Sing a song or two together. #6 Take prayer requests. #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you: the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



Life on Wheels Montgomery, AL

Life on Wheels operates from a mobile ultrasound van to provide free scans to pregnant women. An ultrasound allows a woman to see her baby on a screen. They help pregnant women by fostering loving relationships and serving as a resource to refer them for ongoing support and care. Dr. Matt Phillips, who delivers babies as a profession, was instrumental in shaping the vision for this ministry and serves as the President of the Board of Directors. Trinity member Price Bishop has been part of the ministry since its inception and serves as the Vice President of the Board.

Will you pray for the women and babies who use the services of Life on Wheels? Pray that the women will love and nurture their babies and that their babies will be happy, healthy, and safe. Pray that the women and their babies will know that God loves them and has a plan for their lives.

#460 "Amazing Grace"

Amazing Grace is probably the most recognizable hymn to most Christians. The simple words of this old favorite were written in 1779 by John Newton while living in England. Since his early life was filled with sin, this hymn is thought to have been his own testimony of his conversion and life as a Christian. The melody is an Early American tune of unknown origin. This hymn is of great comfort to the sinner saved by grace! If you believe in Jesus and make Him Lord of your life, He will also forgive you of your sins!

#498 "Jesus! What a Friend for Sinners!"

Jesus is the perfect friend! He is always there to listen when you need someone to talk to, He loves you no matter what, He doesn't judge you or think less of you, and He is always willing to help! Verse 1 says "...friends may fail me, foes assail me, He, my Savior, makes me whole." Sometimes earthly friends can really hurt us. Unfortunately, friends come and go, but Jesus will never leave us and will never hurt us. Don't rely on your friends to make you happy, rely on Jesus and make Him your best friend!
