



Dear Children,

Today is a special day at Trinity because we are talking about missions and missionaries. Missions is about God's plan to save people from every tribe, nation, and language.

You see, a long time ago, in the book of Genesis, we read the story of the nations being created and scattered all over the earth. It is the story of the Tower of Babel. God divided up the people on earth into groups with their own culture and languages. But God did not forget them. From one of those nations, Israel, God saved Abraham. Through him, God said He would save all the nations of the world.

From this one nation of Israel, came Jesus, Who died on the cross and rose from the dead to make a way back to God. Then He sent His people out all over the world to tell the other countries and nations about Him. He said, "Go to all the nations..." 

#264 "Jesus, Keep Me Near the Cross"

Ask Jesus to keep you near the cross. When you are near the cross, you can see beyond what is in front of you to the mercy and healing that is found in Christ. If you keep the cross in the forefront of your mind, you will not focus so much on the negative things in your life. When you lay your cares at the foot of the cross, you can let them go and trust that Jesus will take care of them! So, stay near to the cross. Stay near to the one Who died for you, Who chose you, and Who loves you!

#263 "Lift High the Cross"

Here we find a reminder that we are to hold the cross of Christ ever before our eyes as we await that time when all the world will "adore His sacred name." One day, when Jesus returns to rule the world as King, there will be no more suffering, sadness, pain, evil, or even darkness. It is going to be better than anything you could ever dream of or imagine! The only reason we will be able to be with Jesus in this wonderful place is because He died on the cross for us, because He loves us!
