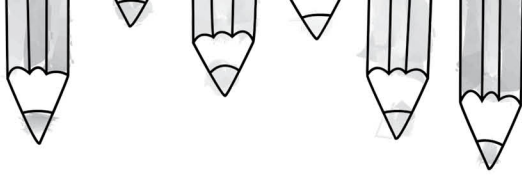

Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

Hope you didn't forget: IT'S MOTHERS DAY!!!

Be sure to tell your mom just how much you love her; serve her today; thank her for all she has done for you; encourage her to rest ALL DAY!

Sometimes mothers have so much on them to take care of you and your daddy. Many of your mothers work as well. They clean and cook and wash clothes and make sure you are taken care of ... and, I hope your daddy helps her!!

But they get worn out. I know I would. And do you know, in many ways, that is where we find David today in Psalm 39. Worn out. Stressed out. Even angry.

Even when I read the Psalm, you will hear David's confusion, frustration, crying out, seeking God, trying to find hope, and wondering what this life is all about. But we learn from David. We learn to seek God! We learn to trust God. We learn to how to pray, and it might just surprise you to hear his prayer.

I hope you know that you can always cry to God; I mean, really cry ... tears. You can show him your emotions: sad, happy, angry, frustrated, scared, stressed, afraid. He is not surprised by your emotion and feelings. He loves you so much.

He loves you so much He sent His only Son to die for you. In fact, on the cross His Son cried out: *My God, My God, why has Thou forsaken Me?* And because God the Father turned His back on God the Son, now when the Son calls YOU to Him, He will not turn His back on you – ever!

It is amazing to think of all the ways God shows you He loves you. Think of some of those ways right now.

Then today, think of the many ways your mother has shown you great love, and remember to thank her.

Suggested questions for Mom and Dad to use this week

1. Mom and Dad, we will continue to encourage you to teach your children the Psalms; to read them; pray them; talk about them; if able, to sing them. Your children will learn so much reading the Psalms with you.
2. You are encouraged to read Mr. Mac's letter to the children before reading Psalm 39 with them. Psalm 39 is powerful; it is different; and it can be complex even for us adults. After listening to today's sermon, try very hard to put this Psalm in words that your children can understand.
3. If you are given to singing, Psalm 90 can be sung to the same tune as "Faith of Our Fathers."
4. Spend time not only today but every day this week telling the mother in the home all the ways you love her and are thankful for her. And pray for her – out loud – with and for her.

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!!

10 EASY STEPS

- #1** Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- #2** Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- #3** It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- #4** Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- #5** Sing a song or two together.
- #6** Take prayer requests.
- #7** Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
- #8** Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9** Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- #10** Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26
The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.

Friendship Mission Montgomery, AL

Friendship Mission provides shelter to approximately 100 men, women, and children in two locations and serves approximately 8,000 meals each month. The men's shelter is on Mobile Highway in West Montgomery. The shelter for women and women with children is located in Chisholm on the North side of Montgomery. The goal of this ministry is to provide residents with the tools they need to repair past mistakes and facilitate independent living. Residents are involved in a variety of activities including basic life skills classes, Bible studies, substance abuse counseling, GED classes, employment, and college courses. These programs are designed to assist residents in transitioning to independent living and are done in partnership with multiple agencies in the River Region to make this program a success. The ministry was started in 1998 by Pastor Vince Rosato and his wife Mary. Trinity Church has supported Friendship Mission since it was formed:
