

Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

This morning I will tell the story in my life when my friends played a trick on me. They didn't want me to be with them, so they tricked me. As they left in the car, I was so sad that my friends had betrayed me... tricked me... and didn't want me with them.

Another time in my life (same year) my mom got sick. When she was so sick, I would feel very alone and sad. It is because of times like this in my life that Psalm 54 means so much to me.

Psalm 54 is telling us what to do when those we love hurt us; when our brothers or sisters let us down; when we feel abandoned or alone; when we are sad.

I hope you will listen this morning and that God will minister to you and your family through this Psalm. I hope you will enjoy singing the hymns. (One of the questions in this Children's Bulletin to think of the hymn that you enjoyed the most and tell your parents why you liked that hymn.)

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use this Week:

- 1. Have you ever been betrayed by a friend? Ever been tattled on? Ever had a friend let you down? When?
- 2. Read Psalm 54 out loud with your family. What means the most to you?
- 3. What was your favorite hymn we sang this morning? Why?
- 4. Can you name some things you know are true about God? Can you say that when you are sad or confused you will try very hard to remember these things you know are true about Him?
- 5. Discuss with your mom or dad: Whatever makes us feel our entire dependence upon God is good for us.
- 6. In what ways is God your helper?
- 7. In what ways does God uphold you?
- 8. Why do we worship God? What has He done that makes us want to worship Him?
- 9. What is Jesus, and what has He done for you?
- 10. "In what ways has this sermon changed your life"

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

#1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family. #2 Try really hard to make the same time every day. #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect. Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional. #4 #5 Sing a song or two together. #6 Take prayer requests. #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church: give thanks. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for. #8 Have a Leader of the <u>Day:</u> they get to read and/or pray and/ #9 or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/ hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day. #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26 The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you: the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you

peace.


