

Dear Children,

When I was your age we had only three or four channels on the TV. And when I was about eight years old, all day everyday on all three major channels for weeks was what was called "Watergate." It was a trial of sorts that revolved around the misconduct of some of our nation's top leaders; even the President of the United States. The President (Nixon) ended up resigning, and many people went to jail.

Today, we hear about the corruption and greed and abuse of power all the time in our nation's capital. It's very sad, and it can be very discouraging. And of course, not all politicians are evil; God has many of His own children who serve us in the government and the military. And our greatest comfort is in knowing that God is in control of all things.

In the Psalm we will look at this morning (Psalm 58), David will complain to God about all the misconduct in the leadership of Israel. And in the Psalm we can learn so much about how to pray for leaders, especially when those leaders are not honoring the Lord.

We have so much to learn about prayer. I hope you are praying. I hope you pray everyday by yourself and with your family; and I hope you enjoy praying with other Christians in worship each Lord's Day. Ask God to teach you how to pray.

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use this Week:

- 1. Can you name any leaders of our country who do not walk with the Lord? What makes you think they may not be Christians?
- 2. Thinking about Psalm 58 and Mr. Mac's sermon, how can we pray for our leaders who do not know the Lord?
- 3. What are some of David's complaints in Psalm 58 about Israel's leaders?
- 4. Mr. Mac used a really big word when talking about this Psalm 58.

The word was "imprecatory." Ask your mom and dad to help you understand what Mr. Mac was talking about Psalm 58 being an "imprecatory Psalm." [Help to Mom and Dad: Mr. Mac said that an "imprecatory Psalm" was a Psalm calling upon God to judge the ungodly. However, Mr. Mac was very clear that this did not stem from an attitude of hatred or revenge; but rather, a siding with God and His righteousness. Help your children understand this biblical way of praying.]

5. How are the wicked described in the Psalm 58? Is it only because of God's grace you are not like them? Why or why not?



Kate and NoNo Beale Isaiah 55 Reynosa, Mexico

Trinity Church members NoNo and Kate Beale started Isaiah 55 Ministries in 2005 in the city of Reynosa, Mexico which is just across the border from McAllen, Texas. Isaiah 55 works among the deaf and marginalized in that city to make disciples, encourage the worship of Jesus, and promote justice and reconciliation.

They began with the deaf education programs which now span from Kindergarten through twelfth grade with follow on vocational programs providing opportunities for manufacturing jobs. The more recent outreach programs center on the neighborhood where the mission house is located and involve special projects, classes and activities to provide economic, educational and spiritual nourishment for the people living in that impoverished community.

Work teams like those which Trinity Church has done for many years provide an opportunity to come alongside the mission staff to encourage, help, and participate in ministry activities.
