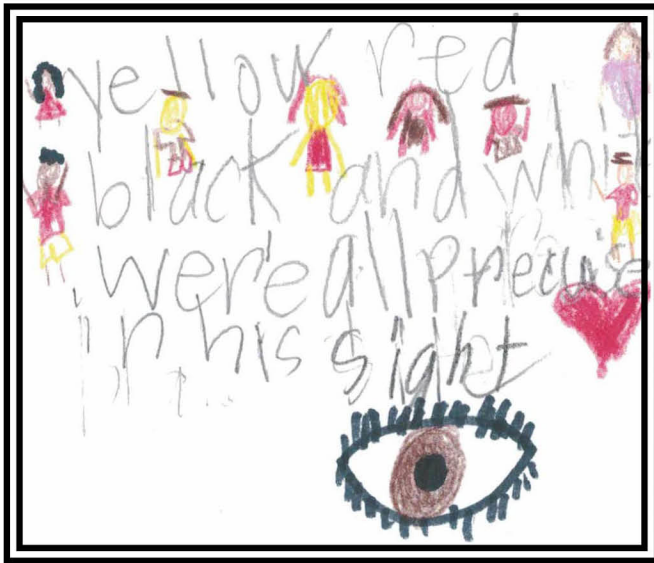


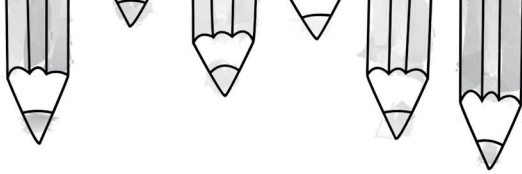

Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

This is one my favorite Psalms in the Bible ~ Psalm 61. I think it's one of my favorites because I have gone to it so many times when I was afraid or struggling or lonely. When I was in college, I learned a tune to this Psalm, and I would sing it a lot. (I still like to sing this Psalm sometimes when I am by myself).

This is a great Psalm to read if you are ever afraid of anything. In fact, you could memorize the first two verses and say them out loud when you go to bed at night.

David gives a great example of prayer in Psalm 61. He also shows us how to be humble before God. One of the ways we can show our humility before God is to recognize that God is so much greater than you: a Rock that is higher than you!

At the end of my sermon I am going to tell part of the story of Pilgrim's Progress when Christian and Hopeful are crossing the river into the Celestial City. Listen carefully to find out why the river was sometimes deeper in some parts than in other parts.

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use this Week:

1. In your own words, what does it mean to say, "God is my Rock?"
2. In what ways can we make God our refuge? How can you run to Him to find shelter? In what ways do we show Him that He is our Rock and Fortress?
3. Read Psalm 61:1-2 with your family. What kind of people pray prayers like that? Have you ever prayed a prayer like that?
4. In what ways does David show humility in Psalm 61? Do we need to show this kind of humility in our prayers? Why or why not?
5. What does it mean that God is a strong tower? Would you feel safe in the strong tower of a castle?
6. Jesus is our Refuge not only from our daily fears and enemies, but also from the wrath of God. Discuss.
7. In the story of Pilgrim's Progress, who was with Christian as he passed over the river? When was the river shallow, and when was it deeper?
8. Describe Heaven.
9. In what ways has this sermon changed your life?

10 EASY STEPS

Meet Our Missionaries!

Isaiah 55
Reynosa, Mexico**

Isaiah 55 is a grace-based ministry whose primary focus is evangelizing the deaf, an unreached people group in Mexico. This is done mainly through education. Isaiah 55 builds schools, trains teachers and then provides a quality education for deaf children with the ultimate goal of sharing the gospel with the students and their families.

Carlos is working as the superintendent and curriculum writer for the school for the Deaf. With all the changes due to Covid, the classes are now online. It has presented challenges, but also new opportunities. Online classes are opening the possibility that deaf kids from remote locations could potentially “attend” classes. Their online sign language classes for the hearing are also booming with new students connecting from distant locations.

Music and Hymns

#164 "O For a Thousand Tongues to Sing"

This hymn is about praising our Lord for the many things He does for us, such as taking away our sins, sorrows, and fears. Charles Wesley wrote this hymn in the 1700's after a bout of illness made him doubt God. He began to read the Bible and the words gave him peace and his faith was restored. Charles wrote this hymn eleven years after his conversion and he recommended it as a hymn for others to sing on the anniversaries of their conversions. Have you ever thought of celebrating the anniversary of your salvation; the anniversary of giving your life to Christ? What song would you choose to praise Him on your conversion anniversary?

#500 "Rock of Ages Cleft for Me"

Jesus is our rock. Genesis 49:24 calls Him "the Rock of Israel." In Numbers chapter 20 there is a rock that springs forth water for the Israelites to drink. This was a foreshadowing of the "living water" Christ would bring to us through His resurrection and the pouring out of the Holy Spirit. When Jesus was on earth, He asked a Samaritan woman for water and she refused Him. Jesus replied, "If you knew the gift of God and Who it is that asks you for a drink, you would have asked Him and He would have given you living water." In John 7:37-39 Jesus says "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them. By this he meant the Spirit..." Have you received living water by believing in Him?
