Dear Children.

Imagine you are very, very thirsty. What does that feel like? It doesn't feel good, does it?

When I am thirsty, and I mean really thirsty, I can't drink the water or juice fast enough.

When I was in high school ~ not too much older then you ~ during basketball practice our coach would let us have water breaks. We would all run to the water fountain trying to be first in line. And if you were not first, and you were waiting in line, you were always saying to the guy at the fountain, "Hurry up." And when it was finally my turn, I would drink as much as I could as fast as I could... often slurping it up!

Well, in our Psalm this morning, Psalm 63, David likens our longing for God to thirsting for Him. When you thirst for something that you know is going to satisfy your thirst, you go after it; in this case, you go after God!

When you thirst for God, you want to worship Him, sing to Him, pray to Him, spend as much time as you possibly can with Him.

And do you know, God always satisfies that thirst. It's called thirst of the soul, and we will always be thirsty in our souls until we quench that thirst with God.

And the only way to truly do that, is to trust in His Son, Jesus, as your own personal Lord of life and Savior from sin.

Are you trusting in Jesus to save you from your sin?



# Friendship Mission Montgomery, AL

Friendship Mission provides shelter to approximately 100 men, women, and children in two locations and serves approximately 8,000 meals each month. The men's shelter is on Mobile Highway in West Montgomery. The shelter for women and women with children is located in Chisholm on the North side of Montgomery. The goal of this ministry is to provide residents with the tools they need to repair past mistakes and facilitate independent living. Residents are involved in a variety of activities including basic life skills classes, Bible studies, substance abuse counseling, GED classes, employment, and college courses. These programs are designed to assist residents in transitioning to independent living and are done in partnership with multiple agencies in the River Region to make this program a success. The ministry was started in 1998 by Pastor Vince Rosato and his wife Mary. Tammy Middleton served as Executive Director following Pastor Rosato's retirement. Tara Davis was named Executive Director in October 2018 to replace Tammy Middleton. Trinity Church has supported Friendship Mission since it was formed.
