

A Guide to Family Worship August 10 - August 15

A Morning Prayer to be Prayed Each Morning as a Family: Psalm 100

Make a joyful shout to the Lord, all you lands! Serve the Lord with gladness; Come before His presence with singing. Know that the Lord, He is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture. Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, And into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name. For the Lord is good; His mercy is everlasting, And His truth endures to all generations.

Suggested Family Worship Topics:

<u>Monday:</u> Read or Sing "Rejoice, the Lord is King" [No. 310 in Trinity Hymnal]

Discuss: How can we show Jesus that He is our King?

Tuesday: Read or Sing "Hail to the Lord's Anointed" [No. 311 in Trinity Hymnal]

Discuss: What does it mean that Jesus' rules in righteousness?

Discuss: Will God give me wisdom if I ask Him for it?

Wednesday: Read or Sing "Christ Shall Have Dominion" [No. 439 in Trinity Hymnal]

Question: For how long will Jesus reign? Has any earthly king ever ruled forever? What is different

about Jesus?

Thursday: Read or Sing "Jesus Shall Reign" [No. 441 in Trinity Hymnal]

Discuss: What does it mean that Jesus reign is boundless, or has no limits? Is there anything or any place or any person that Jesus does not rule?

Friday: Read Psalm 72:12-14

Discuss: In what ways do you know personally that Jesus' rule is compassionate? In what ways has He been compassionate to you?

Saturday: Read Psalm 72:18-19 (Praise to God in preparation for the Sabbath)

Before bed, everyone in the family gathers for prayer. Mom or Dad can read Mr. Mac's letter to the children. After discussing the next morning (getting up, getting dressed, being ready for worship and Sunday School), let every one in the family lie prostrate... on their face, and pray for the Sabbath. Pray for worship, for Mr. Mac, for the one leading the service, for the choir and Mr. Patterson, for the preaching and singing and prayers.



Montgomery Christian School Montgomery, AL

Montgomery Christian School began as a ministry of Trinity Church in our Covenant Building with a Kindergarten class in 2007 with a mission to glorify God by providing an academically challenging education in a Christian environment to families with limited school choice. To that end, the School Vision is to partner with parents to develop academic, social, emotional, and spiritual maturity so that students can effectively pursue God's purpose in their family, church, community, and personal life. It became an independent nonprofit organization in 2009, and gradually grew from Kindergarten to fifth grade as a class was added each year. Trinity Church continues to support this ministry. In 2018, the School purchased the building previously owned by the Green Gate School and is now in its third academic year of serving Montgomery families from that location.

Music and Hymns

#693 "Blessed Assurance"

This hymn was written in 1873 by Fannie J. Crosby. The lyrics are based on Hebrews 10:22-23, which says "let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful." Fannie was a blind hymn writer who wrote over 8,000 hymns in her lifetime. This hymn was especially special to her, as the words of the first verse are even engraved on her tombstone.

#310 "Rejoice, the Lord is King"

Rejoice! Verse 3 proclaims, "His kingdom cannot fail....the keys to death and hell are to our Jesus giv'n." Wow! When the small things in our lives tend to weigh us down, remember that God's kingdom CANNOT FAIL. God cannot lie and God cannot fail. His promises are true and He has prevailed over death and hell. If you belong to Him, you WILL be saved and you belong to His eternal kingdom. Will you spread this Good News?
