

A Guide to Family Worship September 28 - October 3

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use this Week:

- 1. Read Psalm 143 multiple times this week; perhaps in multiple translations.
- 2. Have fun counting up how many days your child has been alive (outside the womb). How many minutes is that? Has there ever been one minute of one day that He did not show you mercy?
- 3. Talk about how much mercy God has shown each one of you. "Count" the ways. Tell Him thank You!!
- 4. Who is our ultimate enemy? How can we fight Him? Prayer, yes; but what does this prayer look like in Psalm 143 (especially in verses 5 and 6).
- 5. Is there anything we cannot ask of God? Look at David's list; it is long. What do you want to ask God for this week? Why? ("Why" is a big part of Psalm 143.)
- 6. What does it look like to be Jesus' servant? How did He serve you? (Matthew 20:28).

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

- #1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- #2 Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- #4 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- #5 Sing a song or two together.
- #6 Take prayer requests.
- #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks
- #8 Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day
- #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



PCA DISCIPLESHIP MINISTRIES LAWRENCEVILLE, GA

The mission of PCA Discipleship Ministries is to glorify God by serving the members and churches of the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA) as they seek to make disciples of all nations (Matthew 28:19). When the PCA began in 1973, the First General Assembly formed the Committee on Christian Education and Publications (now called Committee on Discipleship Ministries) to "assist ... local churches in the task of learning and proclaiming the truth to the end that God's people will be adequately equipped to do the work of ministry."

At its essence, discipleship is the process by which the Holy Spirit brings a sinner to a life-changing knowledge of Christ, using the Word of God and members of the Body of Christ. Discipleship goes beyond evangelism as it includes every aspect of a believer growing in his/her love for and obedience to Christ. In a local church, discipleship ministry is multi-faceted; therefore, the ministry of CDM covers five areas: ministry to children, youth, women, men, and seniors.

They are committed to philosophies and practices that are grounded in covenant theology, whereby God reached out to his fallen creation and began a work of redemption through Jesus Christ. They also seek to promote ministry that enables God's people to engage a fallen world with a Christian worldview, thus participating in God's work of redemption.
