A Guide to Family Worship October 12 - October 16

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use this Week:

- 1. Mom and dad, as always in this series, read this Psalm 145 multiple times this week with your children; and/or read it in its various sections throughout the week. We will look at this Psalm for two weeks; our final Psalm of David in our series.
- 2. If you help your children read Mr. Mac's letter to them, would you please emphasize with them that he loves them, that he wants them to know he is there for them. Also, emphasize the church as a happy, safe place where they will worship, love and be loved, and learn more about their Savior, Jesus Christ.
- 3. There are many Scriptures in the outline to the sermon to help you have passages to read together as a family. You could use the sermon outline as talking points all week to simply remind your children of God's grace, mercy and truth.
- **4. What do we learn about God in this prayer:** God is great. God is good. Let us thank Him for our food.
- 5. Tell your children how much Jesus means to you.

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

- #1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- #2 Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- #4 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- #5 Sing a song or two together.
- #6 Take prayer requests.
- #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks
- #8 Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9 <u>Have a Leader of the Day:</u> they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day
- #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24-26

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



REFORMED UNIVERSITY FELLOWSHIP

Reformed University Fellowship was established in 1971 at the University of Southern Mississippi by Mark Lowery. Eventually, RUF expanded nationally and today is available on 140 campuses. RUF has also expanded internationally, with 4 campuses in Colombia, Mexico, Ukraine, and the Czech Republic.

In all that they do, RUF seeks to be honest. They don't assume a "generic Christianity," but sincerely embrace the system of doctrine set down in a historical document called The Westminster Confession of Faith. This also means that they are open about their affiliation. RUF is the official campus ministry of the Presbyterian Church in America.

RUF wants to create a fellowship of students where every person, regardless of background, personal history, or conviction, can examine the truth claims of Reformed Christianity in a non-threatening atmosphere. Their fellowship on campus is not limited to those who have a prior commitment to being Reformed, Presbyterian or even Christian.

Music and Hymns

#642 "Be Thou My Vision"

The author of this hymn is asking Christ to be several things. The things he asks of the Lord are wonderful and they are things He promises to be to us. Why don't you ask Jesus to be those things to you too? He will! Pray to the Lord: Lord, be thou "my vision," "Lord of my heart," "my wisdom," "my true word," "my great Father," "my battle shield," "my dignity...my delight... my soul's shelter," "my inheritance," "my treasure," and "Heart of my own heart." Jesus longs for you to follow Him!

164 "O for a Thousand Tongues to Sing"

This hymn is about praising our Lord for the many things He does for us, such as taking away our sins, sorrows, and fears. Charles Wesley wrote this hymn in the 1700's after a bout of illness made him doubt God. He began to read the Bible and the words gave him peace and his faith was restored. Charles wrote this hymn eleven years after his conversion and he recommended it as a hymn for others to sing on the anniversaries of their conversions. Have you ever thought of celebrating the anniversary of your salvation; the anniversary of giving your life to Christ? What song would you choose to praise Him on your conversion anniversary?
