



Just a word from Mr. Michael

Dear Children,

How many of you have heard of William Tyndale?

If you have not, then I want to introduce him to you.

William was born over 500 years ago in England. When he went to school, he found out that he was very good with different languages, including Greek. This was important for the work to which he would give his life.

When he finished school, a Mr. Walsh hired him to tutor (or teach) his children. While working for Mr. Walsh, William had many opportunities to meet members and preachers of the local churches. Sadly, the church members & their preachers were shockingly ignorant of the Bible. On one occasion, William declared to local preacher: "If God will spare my life, I will make sure that a plowboy will know more of the Bible than you do!"

At this time, there were no Bibles printed in England. There were no Bibles in English! To make matters worse, the King of England & the Church leaders had forbidden the Bible to be translated into English. Can you believe that?

So, William decided to 'translate' the Bible from Greek and Hebrew into English. To 'translate' means to change words from one language into another or to express the sense of words in a different language. Since it was illegal to do this in England, he had to leave the country in order to do his work. So, he moved to Germany.

Remember that Church leaders did not want people to have the Bible in their own language. Because of that, William had to do much of his work in secret.


After years of work, he completed the English translation and the English Bible was printed in secret.

Because of his work, William was listed among the "Top 10 Most Wanted" criminals. Some people were out to get him arrested. One person, Henry Phillips, became William's friend, but only to betray him. While on a walk together, Henry signaled soldiers to ambush & arrest William. William was quickly put in prison, where he was put to death on October 6, 1536. His last words were a prayer "Lord, open the king of England's eyes!"

While William was in prison, Miles Coverdale published the first-ever complete printed edition of the Bible in English and received permission to distribute it.

William Tyndale may rightly be called "the father of the English Bible." It would not be much of an exaggeration to say that almost every English New Testament until recently was simply a revision of Tyndale's. Some 90% of his words were used in the King James Version of the Bible.



John & Cathy Rug Mission to the World Valparaíso, Chile

The Rugs have served as church planters in Chile since 1986. Trinity Church began supporting them in 1988. Currently, they have a two-pronged ministry of church planting and work among those with disabilities. In 2015, John and Cathy began working with a Presbyterian church plant in Valparaíso where John participates in the ministry of the church leadership. Cathy helps with music and discipleship of women through her quilt evangelism ministry. The Rugs also minister to some of Chile's "disposable" peoples, including the blind through the CEMIPRE Foundation which they founded to facilitate a church-planting movement that reaches this largely overlooked group of people, their relatives, and friends.
