

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use this Week:

#1

- 1. Can you think of someone with whom you have had a hard time getting along? Did you lose your temper with someone this week? Do you need to seek their forgiveness?
- 2. Why should people in the church get along? What happens when they don't get along? What happens to the church? What happens to their witness for Jesus?
- 3. is the Church a building? A steeple? Or is the Church people ... a group of believers?
- 4. Do you know of others who do not get along? Are there people in your family or school or church who you know do not get along? How could you help them?

Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.

5. What does it mean to have your name written in the Lamb's Book of Life? Whose names are there? What happens to those people with Jesus comes back? What does it mean to be "in the Lord?"



Bee Mission to the Unreached Asia

Bee was raised in Thailand and came to faith as a university student there through Cru (formerly known as Campus Crusade). She served with Campus Outreach in her own country and then was part of a Wycliffe Bible translation work. She spent several years in Birmingham, AL and studied at Birmingham Theological Seminary. Within the past 10 years, she changed to evangelistic and discipleship ministries with Mission to the Unreached in remote villages of neighboring countries. She and the team with which she works have seen remarkable growth of churches in these villages as the gospel leads people out of occult tribal religions, transforms lives, and brings people of different ethnicities together to worship the true and living God. Trinity has supported Bee since 1998.

115 "All Creatures of Our God and King"

Psalm 145:10 says that "all You have made will praise You." This hymn not only speaks of creatures, such as humans and animals praising God, but it also speaks of "rushing wind," "clouds that sail," "thou burning sun," "thou silver moon," and "thou flowing water" all praising God.
