

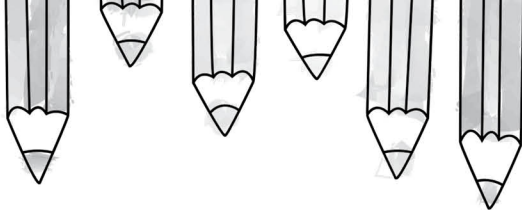

Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

Do you know how many people live on this earth? Somewhere around 2.7 BILLION!!

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use this Week:

1. Mom and Dad, go online at our website or browse through your 24:14 booklet, and spend this entire month each day praying with your children for one of our missionaries.
2. Talk about what missionaries do. Tell them how missionaries are ordinary people like you and me who were called out to a mission field to tell others about Jesus.
3. These passages looked at today would be wonderful for you to read this week as a family: Genesis 1:26-27; Matthew 28:18-20; Revelation 11:15.
4. Memorize Matthew 24:14 as a family:

And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

5. Remember all week in prayer our older members, our widows, those who are most susceptible to the virus, those who are now suffering with the virus at home or in the hospital – especially those who are alone. Pray for your schools. Pray for your teachers. Pray that God would use this pandemic to bring people all over the world to faith in Jesus Christ.

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

- #1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- #2 Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- #4 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- #5 Sing a song or two together.
- #6 Take prayer requests.
- #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks
- #8 Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day
- #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26

Meet Our Missionaries!



Kate and NoNo Beale
Isaiah 55
Reynosa, Mexico

Trinity Church members NoNo and Kate Beale started Isaiah 55 Ministries in 2005 in the city of Reynosa, Mexico which is just across the border from McAllen, Texas. Isaiah 55 works among the deaf and marginalized in that city to make disciples, encourage the worship of Jesus, and promote justice and reconciliation. They began with the deaf education programs which now span from Kindergarten through twelfth grade with follow-up on vocational programs providing opportunities for manufacturing jobs. The more recent outreach programs center on the neighborhood where the mission house is located and involve special projects, classes and activities to provide economic, educational and spiritual nourishment for the people living in that impoverished community.

Work teams, like those which Trinity Church has sent for many years, provide an opportunity to come alongside the mission staff to encourage, help, and participate in ministry activities.

#347 "The Church's One Foundation"

Verse 3 tells how the world views the church and describes the hardships we the saints must endure, but then assures us we, the church, shall never perish!

#524 "Thy Works, Not Mine, O Christ"

We can never do enough good works to be "good enough" for God. God sent His son Jesus Christ as a sacrifice for our sins. His mercy and His grace have set us free. Verse 2 of this hymn says "Thy pains, not mine, O Christ, upon the shameful tree, have paid the law's full price and purchased peace for me."
