

Just a word from Mr. Curles

Dear Children,

Today I want to tell you a little bit about Adoniram Judson, America's first missionary to Asia. He was born in 1788. He was very smart and had many opportunities for a successful life in America, but he believed that God wanted him to go to Burma (Myanmar) as a missionary. So, when he was 25 years old he went to Burma. He spent 37 years in Burma, where he led the conversion of thousands, and suffered the burying of two wives and six children. He is the man that today's Burmese people compare to our national heroes because of his great suffering for them. He sacrificed everything to a cause bigger than himself, and eventually became a great man by making himself small.

Though he possibly could have been the fourth president of the United States, a great Professor, or the Pastor of the largest Church in Boston, he responded to God's call to take the good news of Jesus Christ to people who had never heard of Jesus before. Adoniram Judson died April 22, 1850 and was buried at sea, just off the coast of India, with a funeral having only an audience of a few crew members and one friend. His spiritual life began when he laid down his life to serve Jesus Christ; never looking back. During the Anglo-Burmese War, he spent twenty-one months in prison. Many prisoners died, but his wife Nancy's devotion kept Adoniram alive. She pestered, begged, and bribed people so that she could provide food for her imprisoned husband. She even managed to give Adoniram his personal pillow, into which was sewn his translation of the Burmese Bible. All the while, Nancy was nursing an infant and raising two orphaned Burmese girls. Although he waited six long years for his first convert, not too long after his death there was recorded twenty-one thousand Christians in Burma because of his work, along with a complete Burmese Bible that they still use today.

How can you be a missionary by telling others about Jesus? Telling others about Jesus is the best news we could ever share!



Birmingham Theological Seminary

Birmingham Theological Seminary (BTS) was founded in 1972. Two men saw the need for men and women to be trained for full-time Christian service to enrich their personal lives, to increase their knowledge of the things of the Lord and to be better equipped to teach, preach, and witness for the Lord Jesus Christ. These men also saw the need to enable those who felt God's call to study for Christian work to do so on a part-time basis, if possible to study full-time. Students could have the opportunity to work full-time and also to attend classes in the evening.

Birmingham Theological Seminary's Bibb County Correctional Facility Learning Center brings full seminary training to inmates of the Alabama Department of Corrections. The 15 person cohort studies biblical, systematic, historical, and applied theology, training to become ministers, disciplers, counselors, and evangelists to the 13 prisons of the AL DOC. Their partner ministry, Jumpstart AL, is focused on working with men inside the prison and after they come out, breaking the back of recidivism in Alabama with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

During their 49-year history, more than 3,500 students have taken one or more courses and 350 students have been awarded master's level degrees. BTS has offered courses in various locations around the state of Alabama and in foreign countries such as Uganda, Korea, China, Ukraine, New Zealand, and Australia.
