

This Lord's Day wraps up our month long Missions Conference. I love this Sunday: the flags from different nations, the hymns, and actually seeing the missionaries! This year, however, we are "seeing" missionaries a little differently.

In Sunday School, we have written cards to our Isaiah 55 missionaries, we have "seen" missionaries to other countries and their families by video, and we will "see" and talk to the Stanghelle family this Lord's Day!! In worship today, we will "see" Dr. Lloyd Kim as he preaches to us.

Speaking of Dr. Kim, he and other missionaries from Mission to the World (MTW) have compiled a beautiful children's devotional book devoted to missions called "Let There Be Light." It is a 20-day book of devotions for children. Each day has a devotion, followed by "Let's Pray Together," "Let's Discuss these Questions," and "Let's Read More" which contains suggested scripture readings. This would be a wonderful book for family devotions! Dr. Kim wrote the Foreword to this book, and to quote him, "All people from everywhere were created in the reflection of our one God. Though we may all seem very different, we were all created the same in our worth and value."

Unfortunately, though, another characteristic we all share is sin, but there is hope in our Creator. The one true God. Our missionaries share the one true God and the hope and forgiveness of sin that comes with believing in Him to those people and cultures who don't know Jesus and his great love for all mankind! Please pray for our missionaries if you don't already. Some things you can pray for are success in sharing the Gospel; protection from the Evil One; protection from sickness and injury; and that their financial needs would be provided. 

Meet Our Missionaries!



Athens Church Plant Athens, Greece

Led by Pastor Giotis Kantartzis of the First Greek Evangelical Church and Dr. Argyris Petrou of the Greek Bible College, this Greek Presbyterian congregation of 350 people has established at least four daughter churches with several more in the early stages of planting. Their vision is the transformation of their city spiritually, socially and culturally by the gospel of the grace of God through church planting. To that end they have an aggressive church planting effort. The church planter pastors include George Tolias (Glyfada) Tim Coomar and Alex Pipilios (Exarchia), Stephanos Mihalios (Kypseli), and Manochehr (last name withheld) (Iranian Church). The newest effort is in the Lamprakis Hill neighborhood where Neos Kosmos Church is beginning under the leadership of Tullis and Eric Petrou, but the Glyfada and Exarchia churches each have an additional church plant in preliminary stages from their congregations.
