




A Guide to Family Worship March 22 – March 27

Suggested Questions for Mom and Dad to Use this Week:

- 1. Mom and Dad, what a great opportunity today's worship is to teach your children about: God's generosity, God's blessing the tithe, God's goodness to Trinity Church. List all the ways we are thankful for Trinity Church.
- 2. Another great opportunity this week is to teach your children about tithing. Explain what ten-percent is. Explain how God blesses tithers see Malachi 3:10. Tithers grow in their faith.
- 3. Mom and Dad, teach your children to tithe. They say if you teach them as children it will be a practice they take into adulthood. You are basically teaching them as children how to visibly say "thank You" to God; and don't forget to tell them that He blesses the tithe.
- 4. Talk to your children about all the church has been able to do over the last 15 years by the grace of God; and how they have benefitted: Sunday School Classrooms, Playground, the North Lawn, one day the Frith, Trinity Hall, great food, fun memories, VBS, Created for a Purpose, Movie Night ... and the list goes on and on.
- 5. And by all means, think about today's sermon as a call to your children to put their trust in Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God, Who takes away the sin of the world.

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

- #1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- #2 Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- #4 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- #5 Sing a song or two together.
- #6 Take prayer requests.
- #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks
- #8 Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9 <u>Have a Leader of the Day:</u> they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day
- #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26



Child Evangelism Fellowship Cental Alabame

Child Evangelism Fellowship, also known as CEF, is a Bible-centered, worldwide organization composed of born-again believers, whose purpose is to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and to establish (disciple) them in the local church for Christian living. CEF has over 2,900 missionaries overseas, approximately 2,200 of whom are nationals. In the USA and Canada, 700 full-time workers and an estimated 40,000 volunteers serve the ministry. CEF was founded in 1937 and has grown into the largest evangelistic outreach to children in the world. CEF is currently ministering in countries around the world and in every state in the U.S. Trinity Church has a long-time association with CEF that spans multiple generations and includes members who have hosted clubs in their homes, taught and assisted in running clubs, and have come to faith in Christ by attending weekly meetings.

#32 "Great is Thy Faithfulness"

Our God is faithful! To be faithful means to be loyal, devoted, and unswerving. God is ALWAYS faithful to us. The chorus of this hymn says "all I have needed Thy hand hath provided--Great is Thy faithfulness, Lord unto me!" Even when things seem to be going wrong God is still faithful and He does provide what we need in just the right time that we need it. Can you think of some ways God has been faithful to you and your family?

#457 "Come Thou Fount of Every Blessing"

This hymn talks about the way all believers stray from God at times in their life and how God is faithful to draw us back to Him. His mercy never ceases and He continues to invite us back into His arms when we wander away from Him. In fact, Jesus pursued us when we were yet sinners. Verse 2 says "Jesus sought me when a stranger, wand'ring from the fold of God: He, to rescue me from danger, interposed His precious blood." To interpose means to come between. Jesus has come between you and your sin by cleansing you through the blood He shed on the cross. Isn't that amazing? We did nothing to deserve it and even though we may try, we continue to do wrong, yet He continues to love us! What a wondrous blessing!
