



Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

Today is Palm Sunday: the day we celebrate the courage of our Lord as He set His face toward Jerusalem knowing full-well He was going there to die for you and me.

It is the day of His Triumphal Entry!

And though the people then did not understand His Kingship (they wanted to make Him King then and hoped He would destroy all their enemies), we are blessed to understand that His Kingship is indeed over all, He was going to that place to destroy death, our greatest enemy.

We are thankful for His great courage. We are thankful for His great humility \sim His riding in on the young donkey. We are thankful for all He would endure for us in the next 5-6 days: the pain, the heartache, the beatings, the agony, the cross.

This week on Maundy Thursday, we will remember the Last Supper, the Upper Room, the Garden of Gethsemane, the betrayal, and the trial leading up to the crucifixion.

On Friday night we remember His death at our Tenebrae Service. All is dark and lonely and quiet and reverent.

But on Easter morning, it is bright and glorious! We will celebrate His resurrection from the death; His victory over the grave! And because of HIS victory, we have victory too. If we are alive in Him, we will never die. Our bodies will give out, sure; but our souls will live forever and ever.

It's a wonderful week of remembrance and celebration. I hope you have a great week, and that you will truly remember all He has done for you.



Behold, your king is coming to you; righteous and having salvation is he, humble and mounted on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey."
