

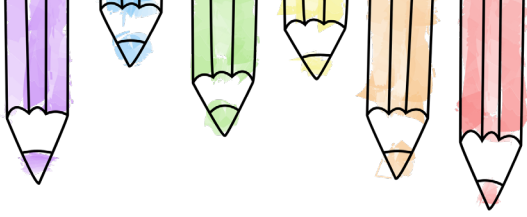

Just a word from Mr. Mac!

Dear Children,

When you are on an Easter Egg Hunt, and you find an egg, what do you do? Do you shout it out? “I found one!” Or are you the quiet kind of egg hunter? Do you just move around finding eggs but not drawing attention to yourself, but collecting as many as you can?!

Some Easter Egg Hunts have something like the Golden Egg! Sometimes it has money in it, or maybe more candy! And I don’t know anyone who would find the Golden Egg and not want to scream: “I FOUND IT!”

Well, do you know that we have a very special treasure--much more special than an Easter Egg-- but we never shout about it. We never tell others we “found it.” We never seem to share with others that we have it. I’m referring to the Gospel. We have it. We believe it. We “own” it. But we seldom share it with others.

I hope you will grow up and never be ashamed to tell others the hope that is in your heart; that Jesus is alive and lives in your heart; that you have hope and you would like nothing more than to share it with someone.

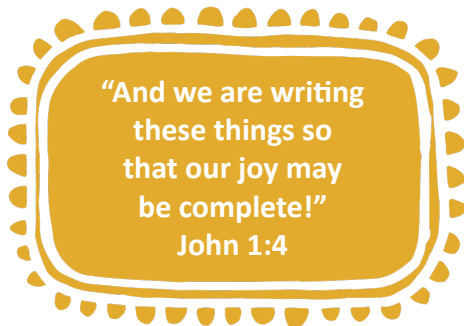

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!!
10 EASY STEPS

- #1** Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.

- #9** Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- #10** Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26

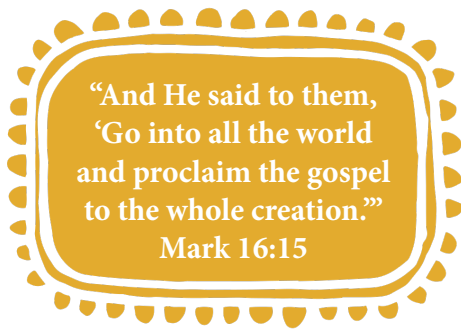
