




# Faith Radio Montgomery, AL

Faith Radio began transmitting at 89.1 FM in 1984. The call letters, WLBF, were chosen, standing for "We Live By Faith". Today, they broadcast in Alexander City, Brewton, Dothan, Eufaula, Sylacauga, Thorsby/Jemison, Haiti, on channel 104 in Baptist Health hospitals in Montgomery and Prattville, and by Faith Radio app, available for download on iPhone, iPad, and Android devices. Faith Radio's mission is to serve the Christian Community and strengthen the local church and family unit by providing spiritual encouragement and a personal challenge with a Christ centered focus, through Biblical teaching, relevant information and uplifting music to the Glory of God.
