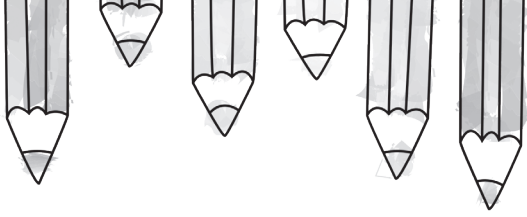

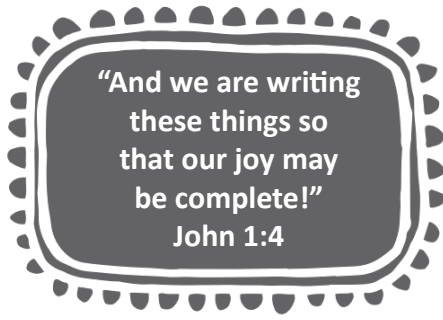

Suggested questions for mom and dad to use this week:

1. Mom and Dad, you might want to read through John 4:1-42 one more time and retell the story in your own words. After this week, we will move on to another story.
2. What is revival?
3. How can we “help” bring about revival? (Mom and Dad: pray, befriend, live like Christians, show hospitality – what other ways can your family think of to bring about revival in our city, country and the world?)
4. From what do we need to be saved? Mr. Mac lists nearly 8 things in his sermon. Of course, SIN is the “number one answer.”
5. Retell the story of the children who were saved in their school in 1859 in Northern Ireland. Could that happen here? Why, or why not?

THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!! 10 EASY STEPS

- #1 Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- #2 Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- #3 It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- #4 Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- #5 Sing a song or two together.
- #6 Take prayer requests.
- #7 Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
- #8 Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- #9 Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- #10 Dad, pray this over your children: Numbers 6:24–26
The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.



Joe and Becky Harrell Mission to the World Colombia

Joe and Becky’s covenantal training by godly parents and faithful churches is central to their calling as missionaries and their vision for Latin America. Upon completing his studies at Reformed Theological Seminary, Joe served churches in Alabama for seven years.

The Harrells joined MTW in 1986 and have worked in Mexico in church planting, assisting national church planters, and in theological education (1989-2006). Answering God’s calling upon their lives, they are now working with the growing reformed Presbyterian church in Colombia, South America. While the primary task is church-based training of Presbyterian pastors and elders (through church planting), ministry opportunities extend far beyond our denomination to other evangelical churches and leaders who are hungry for the reformed faith.

Please pray that God will raise up strong leaders in the homes and in the churches of Colombia and throughout Latin America. Pray that faithful men will be used by our Sovereign God to bring about reformation resulting in the transformation of culture for the glory of God. Pray that God will equip the churches to send their own missionaries. And, as always, please pray for Joe and Becky’s health and safety.

Music and Hymns

"Before the Throne of God Above"

Did you know your name is written in God's hands and heart? Can you believe it? Isaiah 49:16 says "Behold, I have engraved you on the palms of my hands." Would you ever forget about someone whose name was inscribed in your hand? It would be a constant reminder to think about and pray for that person and that is exactly what God does for us. You can rest assured He knows YOUR name. He is our "perfect, spotless righteousness." No one can ever snatch us from His hand. Come boldly before His throne. He longs to hear from you, and comfort you, and answer your prayers.

#693 "Blessed Assurance"

This hymn was written in 1873 by Fannie J. Crosby. The lyrics are based on Hebrews 10:22-23, which says "let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful." Fannie was a blind hymn writer who wrote over 8,000 hymns in her lifetime. This hymn was especially special to her, as the words of the first verse are even engraved on her tombstone.
