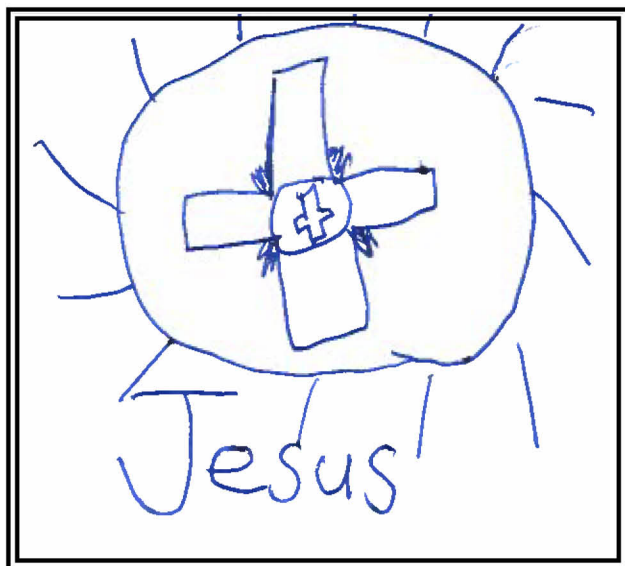


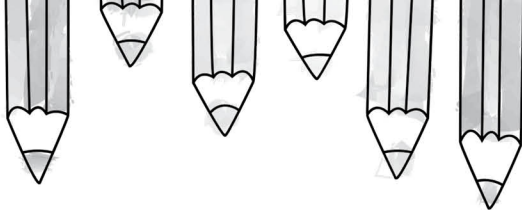

Just a word from Mr. Mac



#353 "I Love Thy Kingdom, Lord"

Do you love the church? When you hear the word "church" you probably think about the physical building that Trinity Church is housed. You should love the church you attend, but you should also love the church as a whole. When the Bible mentions "the church" it is talking about all believers around the world. You are a part of Trinity Church, but you are also a part of a much larger church that is made up of billions of believers all around the world. Isn't that neat?

#296 "All Hail the Power of Jesus' Name"

Philippians 2:9 says that Jesus' name is above every other name. There are places in the Bible where people were healed simply by having faith in Jesus. We pray in His name because there is power in His name. We are baptized in His name. Demons have been cast out in His name. In the Christmas story, the book of Matthew quotes the prophet Isaiah in saying "Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son and they shall call His name Immanuel." Immanuel means "God with us." Jesus, which is Yeshua in its original Hebrew form, means "He will save or the Lord saves." Jesus was a fairly common name when Jesus was born, but He was and is the only one who is "God with us" and it is only by His name that we are saved!
