

## Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

Do you remember the day of your baptism? Do you remember when the minister held you in his arms and poured water on your head? Do you remember your mom and dad standing there with you?

Of course you don't! You were a baby! Probably between 3-6 months old!

It IS something to think about: what is your first memory?

I remember meeting a friend when I was three years old. I remember the day we met. And I remember his mom dropping him off at my house to play.

When we have baptisms like we do today, it is nice if you can think about what baptism means. When I pour the water on the baby's head, you should think about how that reminds you of Jesus washing you with His blood – washing away all your sin and remembering it no more. That's how much He loves you.

In fact, during a baptism, you should think about how much He loves you. That He saved you, adopted you, has forgiven you, lives in you and helps you, and one day you will live with Him forever.

Today's subject on the Lord's Supper and Baptism, which we call sacraments, will be a bit deep and a little harder to understand. But I plan to talk to YOU a lot this morning. I want to be preaching to YOU about things you can think about during the Lord's Supper and Baptism.

I wonder who baptized you. Was it me? Was it Mr. Howell? I know if Mr. Howell is your grandfather that he baptized YOU, and those were very special days in our church. All of your baptisms have been so special to this church and us ministers. It is such a privilege to baptize. God is so good.


