


A Guide to Family Worship January 10 - January 15

Questions for Mom and Dad to use this week:

- 1. Challenge: read Romans 11:33-36 twice a day as a family. Perhaps at breakfast or on your way to school; then again before you go to bed. Begin and end the day in praise for Who God is.
- 2. Understanding and teaching "the means of God's grace" can be tricky. There are means that God has given us, and they are double-sided; active and passive. They are His gift to us; His means to grow us up into Christ; His means of growing His Church. At the same time, we involve ourselves in them.

Perhaps you can take the twelve means of grace that are listed in the sermon outline, and teach your children like this: We pray for lots of reasons. One reason is because God has blessed us with the ability to pray; to go before Him and tell Him anything; to thank Him. But it is also true that God blesses us when we pray. He gives us peace and comfort and joy in prayer.

- 3. Use the list in the sermon outline to pray for Trinity Church this week. Your prayers will make Trinity all the better/stronger for it.
- 4. Mom and dad, one of the greatest gifts you can give your children is your own spiritual growth. Be encouraged to be in worship; to be involved in your Sunday School Class; and to have a small group and/or a prayer partner.



This hymn reminds us of what Jesus has done for us. He "yielded His life an atonement for sin, and opened the lifegate that we may go in." Jesus gave His life for us so that we may be forgiven of our sins and live in Heaven with Him for all eternity. Did you know that Jesus doesn't just save good people? He will also save those who have done terrible things if they believe in Him. Verse 2 says "the vilest offender who truly believes, that moment from Jesus forgiveness receives."

#252 "When I Survey the Wondrous Cross"

Do you ever stop to take a real close look at the cross and what it meant for Jesus to have to die on that terrible instrument of torture for your very own sins? Many people don't like to think about the price Christ had to pay because those thoughts are just too painful. We might not be murderers or thieves, but we all have pride in our hearts. "Sorrow and love flow mingled down" means that as he was dying for us, he had the mixed emotions of love and sorrow at the same time. In the 4th verse, we see where Isaac Watts, the hymn writer, concludes that "love so amazing and divine demands our soul, our life, OUR ALL!
