


Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

This morning, the adult Sunday school classes got a chance to hear from William Stabler, who now works with Reformed University Fellowship, and attended TPC when he was in High School, and Greg and Julieann Allen who work with Global Serve International.

William Stabler is working with Reformed University Fellowship (RUF), a ministry that ministers to college students, to help connect the work of RUF to Mission to the World (MTW). He helps connect RUF students to short-term opportunities with MTW. The goal is for these short-term opportunities to lead to long-term missionary work in the field.

Greg Allen, after spending many years in North and Central Asia ministering to unreached people groups, worked with several others to found Global Serve International, which helps workers gain access to unreached people groups. He serves today as the International Director, and splits his time between equipping our church planters in overseas fields, and speaking at churches all over the US.

Tonight, we will hear from Rev. Ken Austin, the pastor and founder of New Walk of Life Church, as well as the founder and Executive Director of Mercy House and M.A.P. (Ministry About People) here in Montgomeryfc. Rev. Austin has also been on the board of directors with Common Ground Montgomery and has served as their director of operations and community relations. He has also served on the boards of Valiant Cross Academy, the Mental Health Authority, and House to House and he is a member of Montgomery Police Department's Good Shepherd program. Additionally, Rev. Austin is one of the leaders in the OUR Montgomery Prayer Walk gatherings that brings people from across our city together for prayer in a different neighborhood on the first Saturday of every month.



Jonah and Jennifer Asia

The work of Jennifer and Jonah is so sensitive that we cannot share their actual names or location. Their Muslim country is ranked within the top five of all nations for extreme religious persecution against Christians. Radical factions are the most visible threat, but the most common source of danger for a convert is their own family. Conversion from Islam is seen as cause for shame and blasphemy. In spite of this hostility, the church exists and even meets regularly and openly in some places, although covertly in others. Jonah fills preaching, teaching, and discipleship roles and travels frequently to meet with churches and groups of believers.
