

Dear Children,

This morning, the adult Sunday school classes got a chance to hear from Caroline and Carter McWhorter who work for MTW in Thailand, and Bee who works in Asia; Bee will also give a testimony tonight at the Evening Vespers service. Rev. Paul Hahn will be preaching in the morning and evening services.

Paul Hahn is Interim Pastor at Pacific Crossroads in Manhattan Beach, CA and has planted numerous churches in the United States. Paul was formerly the RUF Campus Minister at Auburn University. Paul spent two years on staff with Cru/Athletes in Action and planted the AIA chapter at the University of Florida. He has also served as Coordinator of Mission to North America (MNA), the Presbyterian Church in America's (PCA) agency giving leadership and direction to church planting, church renewal and missional partnerships throughout the United States and Canada.

Bee was raised in Thailand and served with Campus Outreach and then was part of a Wycliffe Bible translation work. She spent several years in Alabama studying at Birmingham Theological Seminary. She currently serves in evangelistic and church planting ministries with Ambassadors for Christ International in remote villages of Asia.

Carter and Caroline (Clark) McWhorter were married in 2021 and are preparing to serve with a Mission to the World church planting team in Thailand. Caroline was raised in Alabama and attended Trinity Presbyterian Church. During college, she served as a Summer intern with a mission organization in East Asia. This ignited a passion for missions and, following her graduation, she spent two more years as a short-term missionary in East Asia, where she met Carter.


