



Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

This morning, the adult Sunday school classes got a chance to hear from Jim and Linda Sims who work for Ethnos360, and Tim and Kristy Holliday who work for Isaiah 55 in Reynosa, Mexico. Rev. Ronnie Stevens will be preaching in the morning and evening services.

Ronnie Stevens is the Associate Minister at Harvest Church. He has served as a pastor in many countries, including Germany, the Soviet Union, Romania, Czechoslovakia, Hungary, Poland, and Russia. Following a total of twenty-four years of ministry overseas, he and his wife, Jane, settled in Germantown, Tennessee.

Jim and Linda Sims are members of Ethnos360, formed as New Tribes Mission in 1942. Jim flew airplanes and helicopters in Papua New Guinea for eleven years. Linda flight followed for Jim, monitoring the radio and reporting the weather. Jim was Chairman and Chief Pilot for the Papua New Guinea Flight Program. In McNeal, AZ, he served as Chairman for the global NTM Aviation flight program. His current responsibility is Member Relations for Ethnos360 Aviation. Linda assists Jim with correspondence and administration.

Tim and Kristy Holliday work for Isaiah 55 Ministries and work among the deaf and marginalized in Reynosa, Mexico, to make disciples, encourage the worship of Jesus, and promote justice and reconciliation. The deaf education programs are targeted to students in kindergarten through high school with follow-up vocational programs providing opportunities for manufacturing jobs. The outreach programs involve special projects in the neighborhood, providing economically and spiritually for those in the community. The work teams provide an opportunity to assist the missions staff to encourage, help, and participate in missions activities.



Meet Our Missionaries!



Greg and Julieann Asia

Julieann and Greg went to Siberia with two young sons in 1994 to work among an Unreached People Group in that remote, frozen land. While Rujak is not their real name, this group includes over 500,000 people. Only .07% of this population is considered Christian. The Allens established a church plant that has grown over the years into a network of churches. Greg is part of a leadership team that strategically focuses on other unreached people groups across the Asian region in places that are not open to normal mission efforts. The goal in each location is to establish a locally lead, self-sustaining church movement that will bear witness to the Gospel within that culture.
