




# Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

I can remember when I was your age sitting in church, and it came time for the collection (or the offering). My dad would get out three dollar bills, and pass one to each of his children; my two sisters and me.

I always liked that part of the offering, and now as a father, I realize my dad was teaching me the importance of giving to the church...giving back to God...giving Him a portion of what He has given to me.

Giving to the church is a way of saying, "Thank you," to God. Of course, we could never, ever repay Him for what He has done for us, but our offering is a token of gratitude. We are saying, "Thank You for all You have done for me." This is Stewardship Sunday at Trinity Church. Stewardship is a matter of taking care of that which God has given you. And do you know that everything you have is a gift from God?! You can't name one thing that isn't a gift from God to you.

He wants you to be a good steward of your money, your health, your talents, your family, schoolwork, your reading assignments, your memory work, your "extra time," your friends, your pets...everything. He wants you to take care of these things and use them to His glory.

One of the ways we do that with money is by giving back to Him a portion of what He has given us. Your mom and dad are paid for the work they do. They give to Him at least 10% of what they make. In other words, if your mom or dad makes \$10.00, they give God back one dollar; realizing, of course, that God owns it all!

That's good stewardship, and that is what we will be talking about today.



#### Child Evangelism Fellowship Central Alabama

Child Evangelism Fellowship, also known as CEF, is a Bible-centered, worldwide organization composed of born-again believers, whose purpose is to evangelize boys and girls with the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ and to establish (disciple) them in the local church for Christian living. CEF has over 2,900 missionaries overseas, approximately 2,200 of whom are nationals. In the USA and Canada, 700 full-time workers and an estimated 40,000 volunteers serve the ministry. CEF was founded in 1937, and has grown into the largest evangelistic outreach to children in the world. CEF is currently ministering in countries around the world and in every state in the U.S. Trinity Church has a long time association with CEF that spans multiple generations of people who hosted clubs in their homes, taught and assisted in running clubs, and came to faith in Christ and discipleship by attending weekly meetings.

# Music and Hymns

#### "Come, Thou Fount of Every Blessing"

This hymn talks about the way all believers stray from God at times in their life and how God is faithful to draw us back to Him. His mercy never ceases and He continues to invite us back into His arms when we wander away from Him. In fact, Jesus pursued us when we were yet sinners. Verse 2 says "Jesus sought me when a stranger, wand'ring from the fold of God: He, to rescue me from danger, interposed His precious blood." To interpose means to come between. Jesus has come between you and your sin by cleansing you through the blood He shed on the cross. Isn't that amazing? We did nothing to deserve it and even though we may try, we continue to do wrong, yet He continues to love us! What a wondrous blessing!

#### "Join All the Glorious Names"

Isaac Watts originally wrote 12 stanzas for this hymn and included 17 names for Christ. He wrote several hymns of the same theme, but finally decided "Earth is too narrow to express His worth, His glory, or His grace."
