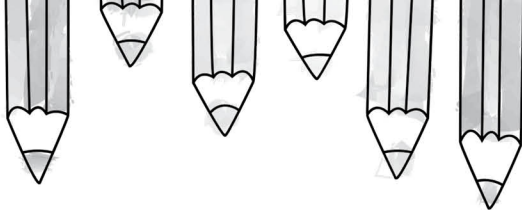

Just a word from Mr. Mac

Dear Children,

How do people become Christians?

More times than not, God the Father sends one of His children like you and me to tell them about the love of Jesus. God will send missionaries to the four corners of the earth to tell the lost (those who do not know God) about how much God loves them, and that He sent His Son to die for them.

So, yes, we think of missionaries, preachers, and Sunday School teachers to proclaim God's Good News; to teach people about Him; to share with them about how they became Christians.

But do you know who else He sends? You and me.

That's right. He sends us every day to other people who do not know Him ~ or to visitors in your home or to your neighborhood friends or school friends or maybe your grandparents or someone on your baseball team.

Telling others about Jesus is called evangelism. Evangelism is telling others about the Good News. Your prayer is that God will bring people like that into your life, and that He would use you to help them understand what God has done for them.

This morning I will preach on reasons why we find it hard to do this; what exactly it is we are sharing with others; some ways we can do it; the people to whom we are to share; and finally, why we do it. And I'll go ahead and tell you: the main reason we do it is because of the love of God. The love of God for you.

Because God loves you, you will want others to know what that is like. You will want others to know God and Who He is ~ our wonderful, gracious, loving, forgiving God.

I hope you enjoy worshiping Him this morning.



"How Sweet the Name of Jesus Sounds"
