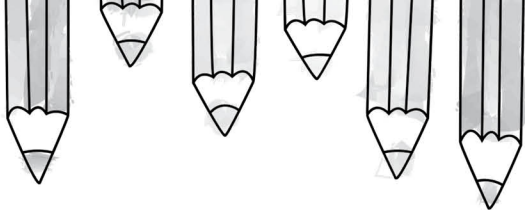

# Just a word from Mr. Michael

Dear Children,

During a regular school day, do you have a favorite time of the day? Is it lunch? Could it be time to play outside or to go on a trip? In this passage, Jesus talked about a very important time that He called *"the hour"*.

*"The hour"* was special to Jesus. He describes it as the time for the *"Son of Man"* to be glorified. Jesus often called Himself the *"Son of Man"*.

What did Jesus mean when He talked about being *"glorified"*? In the gospel of John, it means the time of Jesus' suffering and death.

So, for Jesus to talk about *"the hour"* having arrived, He meant that it was the time for Him to be crucified on the cross.

The good news about this is that the cross was not the defeat of Jesus. It was the victory of God! What Jesus did on the cross was to work out the way for sinners to be saved. Jesus completely worked it out! He did it!

Now, we are called on to trust Him for the way He worked it out. We can be included among the children of God because of what Jesus, the *"Son of Man"*, did during *"the hour"*!

### **THE SIMPLEST OUTLINE FOR FAMILY TIME EVER!!!**

#### **10 EASY STEPS**

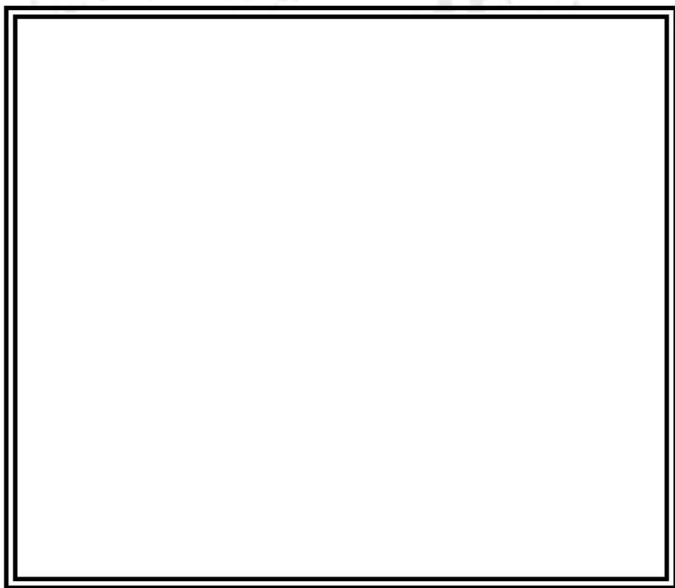
