




Just a word from Mr. Kurt

Dear Children.

Have you ever had trouble finding something you need? Have you ever seen your mom or dad looking for their wallet, phone, car keys or purse? Have you ever been stuck and unable to find your other shoe? Have you ever been looking for something and then realized it was right beside you or even in your hand all along? I remember a time when I was a child and my mom asked me to run over to the neighbor's house because she was sure she'd left her glasses there. Her glasses were resting on her head the entire time. That can happen to any of us. We look and look for something, but even though it's right beside us, we just miss it. In John 12:37 the Scriptures say, "Though [Jesus] had done so many signs before them, they still did not believe in him." These people had seen Jesus feed five thousand people with one child's lunch. They had seen him heal the sick and give sight to the blind. And yet, they didn't believe. They were so close to the Son of God, and just missed him. I want you to be careful not to do the same. You are blessed to be born into a Christian family and raised in the church. You get to hear about Jesus and the good news of the Gospel several times a week. But even people who are that close to the truth sometimes miss it. They choose to chase after the glory that comes from people rather than the glory that comes from God. You can ask your parents to pray with you and for you. Ask them to pray that you would love Jesus first and best because he loved you first and best. Pray and ask Jesus to help you trust him. He tells us that if we ask him for help, he is ready to give it. May the Lord bless you and keep you.



Faith Radio Montgomery, AL

Faith Radio began transmitting at 89.1 FM in 1984. The call letters "WLBF" were chosen, standing for "We Live by Faith." Today, they broadcast in Alexander City, Brewton, Dothan, Eufaula, Sylacauga, Thorsby/Jemison, Haiti, in Baptist Health Hospitals, and by the Faith Radio app. Faith Radio's mission is to serve the Christian Community and strengthen the local church and family unit. They provide spiritual encouragement through biblical teaching, relevant information, and uplifting music to the Glory of God.

Music and Hymns

"O Christ, Our King, Creator, Lord"

Is Jesus a human or is He God? If you said 'yes', you're right! Jesus, our great savior, is 100% God, but at the same time, 100% human. How can this be? Because God can do anything. He can do things we can't even imagine! That's what this hymn is about. The third verse says: 'Thou didst create the stars of night; yet Thou hast veiled in flesh Thy light, hast deigned a mortal form to wear, a mortal's painful lot to bear.' That basically means that God, who invented this whole beautiful world - who made the flowers, the trees, the clouds, and who made you and me - that same creator loved us so much that He became a human, just to save us from hell and crying, and pain, and sadness. He is so, so good to us.

Here are some verses about Him in Hebrews chapter 2:

"'Behold, I and the children God has given me.' Since therefore the children share in the flesh and blood, He Himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death He might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the devil, and deliver all those who through fear of death were subject to lifelong slavery...therefore He had to be made like His brothers in every respect, so that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people."

This is what the Lord says – your Redeemer, Who formed you in the womb: I am the Lord, Who has made all things.
