

The simplest outline for family time ever! 10 Easy Steps

- 1. Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- 2. Try really hard to make the same time every day.

- 5. Sing a song or two together.
- 6. Take prayer requests.
- 7. Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
- 8. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- 9. Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.

First Choice Women's Medical Center (Montgomery, Alabama)



"It Is Well With My Soul"

When Horatio Spafford wrote this hymn in 1873 he had just experienced a great loss in his family. He had already lost his son to Scarlet Fever and list his wealth in the Great Chicago Fire, and in 1873 he lost his 4 daughters in a shipwreck. As he was on his way to meet his grieving wife he wrote this hymn, "It Is Well with My Soul." How do you react in times of trouble and sadness? Is your soul well in any circumstance? We should rest in the fact that the Holy Spirit is always with us and Jesus is always there to hear our prayers. This hymn is a great example of how, as Christians, we can have peace no matter what happens in our lives.

"How Sweet the Name of Jesus Sounds"

In Jesus' time, His name was very common. In Hebrew it would be Yeshua, which would translate to Joshua in English. Although His name was common, Jesus was everything BUT common. To us, His name represents salvation, freedom, hope, love, grace, mercy and so many more things! When we hear His name, we should be comforted by the fact that He loves us, He chose us, He forgives us no matter what we do, and He has gone to prepare a place for us so that we can live with Him forever!
