

A GUIDE TO Family Worship



The simplest outline for family time ever! 10 Easy Steps

- 1. Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
- 2. Try really hard to make the same time every day.
- 3. It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- 4. Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
- 5. Sing a song or two together.
- 6. Take prayer requests.
- 7. Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
- 8. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- 9. Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- 10. Dad, pray this over your children: Number 6:24-26


Nono and Kate Beale Isaiah 55 (Reynosa, Mexico)

Kate and NoNo are from Montgomery, Alabama, and members of Trinity Presbyterian Church. They have been serving in Mexico since 1999. NoNo is the director of Isaiah 55 Ministries. This ministry works among the deaf and marginalized to make disciples, promote justice and reconciliation, and encourage the worship of Jesus. Isaiah 55 has the privilege of hosting work teams from all over the US, providing them an opportunity to participate in short-term mission projects such as construction, mercy ministries, VBS, ESL, sports clinics, and medical missions.

"Here, O My Lord, I see Thee Face to Face"

This is a perfect hymn for communion. Most of you have probably never taken communion, but I am sure you have seen it and heard about it. We eat bread and drink grape juice, which symbolize Jesus' body and blood shed on the cross for our sins. Taking communion is a very intimate moment with Jesus. Verse 4 says, "Mine is the sin, but Thine the righteousness; mine is the guilt, but Thine the cleansing blood." Communion is a reminder that Christ died for our sins, and we do it in remembrance of Him!

"Be Thou My Vision"

The author of this hymn is asking Christ to be several things. The things he asks of the Lord are wonderful, and they are things He promises to be for us. Why don't you ask Jesus to be those things for you too? He will! Pray to the Lord: Lord, be thou "my vision," "Lord of my heart," "my wisdom," "my true word," "my great Father," "my battle shield," "my dignity...my delight...my soul's shelter," "my inheritance," "my treasure," and "Heart of my own heart." Jesus longs for you to follow Him!
