

A GUIDE TO *Family Worship*



The simplest outline for family time ever! 10 Easy Steps

1. Just make sure you gather once a day as a family.
2. Try really hard to make the same time every day.
3. It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
4. Read a Bible verse. Maybe a devotional.
5. Sing a song or two together.
6. Take prayer requests.
7. Pray. (Daddy, your children NEED to hear you pray.) Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
8. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
9. Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
10. Dad, pray this over your children: Number 6:24-26


Mercy House — Montgomery, Alabama

Mercy House is a “day house” providing a safe place for people in need. This ministry provides a safe haven for the homeless, allowing them to get a hot meal, take showers, and wash their clothes. Mercy House is a safe place for children to stop in and receive an after-school snack and play in a godly environment. The facility has two full bathrooms with showers, washers and dryers, a food pantry, a clothes closet, and supervised internet access for schoolwork and job searches.


Sermon Art

Music and Hymns



“O for a Thousand Tongues to Sing”

This hymn is about praising our Lord for the many things He does for us, such as taking away our sins, sorrows, and fears. Charles Wesley wrote this hymn in the 1700s after a bout of illness made him doubt God. He began to read the Bible, and the words gave him peace, and his faith was restored. Charles wrote this hymn eleven years after his conversion, and he recommended it as a hymn for others to sing on the anniversaries of their conversions. Have you ever thought of celebrating the anniversary of your salvation—the anniversary of giving your life to Christ? What song would you choose to praise Him on your conversion anniversary?
