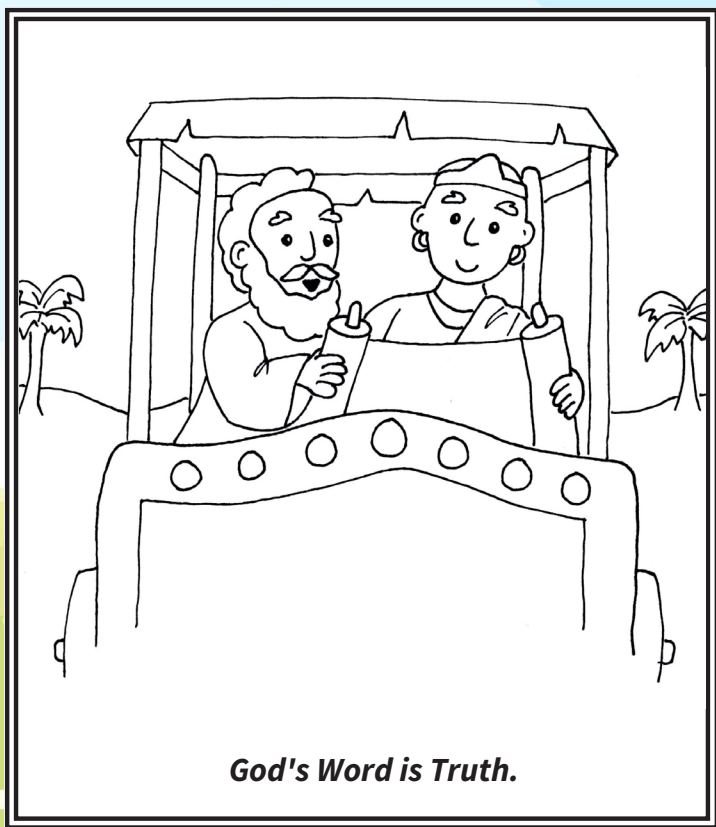

A GUIDE TO *Family Worship*

"Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth! I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old, things that we have heard and know, that our fathers have told us. We will not hide them from their children, but tell them to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might, and the wonders that he has done." Psalm 78:4



Parents, you have the joyful responsibility to teach the next generation the glorious deeds of the Lord. Use this list as a simple guide to help your family worship time.

1. Try to gather once a day as a family. Try to make it the same time and place every day.
2. It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
3. Read scripture from the Bible, sing a song or two, pray. Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
4. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
5. Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
6. Additional options: read a devotion or Bible story book in addition to scripture, read through a particular book of the Bible and work your way through the entire Bible, take prayer request or take turns praying, review memory work and catechism questions.
7. Parents, pray this over your children:

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace. Numbers 6:24-26

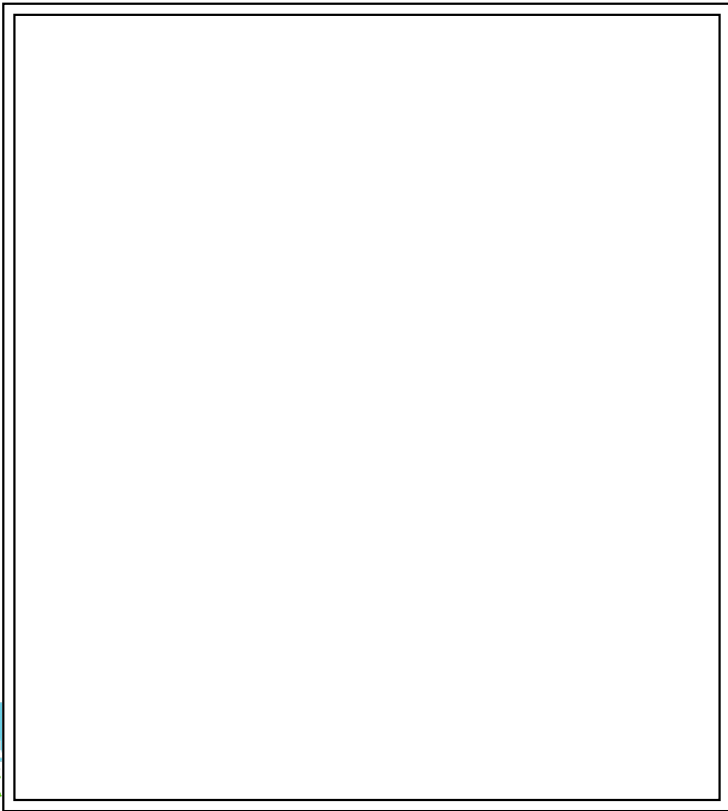
Meg Randall Flores

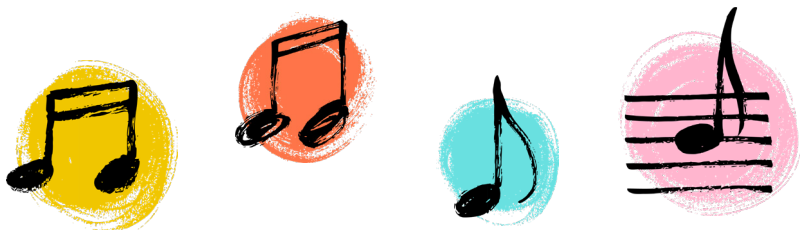

"I Sing the Mighty Power of God"

It has been said, Tell me what you sing, and I'll tell you who you are! That means what we sing becomes what we believe and think. This is why the writer of this hymn, Isaac Watts, wrote it specifically for children. He wanted the words to be true about who God is and what He has done, but simple enough to be easily remembered by everyone, no matter how young! The main theme in this hymn is that God is powerful, God is good, and He created good things. Often, we sinful humans use our power to hurt those who are weak, but God is not like that. All of the earth and all that is in it reveal how awesome God is. Remember, God is in control of everything—even the wind, seas, and stars!

"May the Mind of Christ My Savior"

Philippians 2:5 says, "Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus. This hymn says that we can have Jesus' mind, word, peace, love, and beauty in our lives each day. How is that possible? God gave us the Holy Spirit to be our guide, our comforter, and our helper. Pray that the Holy Spirit would give you the mind of Christ so that you can obey His Word, feel His peace, and love others as He
