

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# A GUIDE TO *Family Worship*

*"Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth! I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old, things that we have heard and know, that our fathers have told us. We will not hide them from their children, but tell them to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might, and the wonders that he has done." Psalm 78:4*



Parents, you have the joyful responsibility to teach the next generation the glorious deeds of the Lord. Use this list as a simple guide to help your family worship time.

1. Try to gather once a day as a family. Try to make it the same time and place every day.
2. It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
3. Read scripture from the Bible, sing a song or two, pray. Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
4. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
5. Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
6. Additional options: read a devotion or Bible story book in addition to scripture, read through a particular book of the Bible and work your way through the entire Bible, take prayer request or take turns praying, review memory work and catechism questions.
7. Parents, pray this over your children:

*The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace. Numbers 6:24-26*


## **Family Promise of Montgomery Montgomery, Alabama**

Family Promise of Montgomery works with local congregations to offer homeless families safe shelter, nutritious meals, warm hospitality, transportation, and weekly case management while they work to become self-sufficient. In 2021, Family Promise secured a small apartment building with four separate units that will be used to host the families while they look for something more permanent. During the day, guests go to work while their children go to school. If the adult guests do not have jobs, they spend the day at the Day Center, where they receive help with locating a job, clearing up credit issues, and other case management matters.



## **“Like a River Glorious”**

This song proclaims, “They who trust Him wholly find Him wholly true.” Do you wholly trust God? When you trust God, you can rest in Him and know that He is going to handle every worry you may have. Verse 2 says that there is a peace God can give where there is “not a surge of worry, not a shade of care.” When you are worried about something, put your trust in God and ask Him to help you. Keep your eyes on God, and He will give you peace!

## **“When I Survey the Wondrous Cross”**

Do you ever stop to take a real close look at the cross and what it meant for Jesus to have to die on that terrible instrument of torture for your very own sins? Many people don't like to think about the price Christ had to pay because those thoughts are just too painful. We might not be murderers or thieves, but we all have pride in our hearts. “Sorrow and love flow mingled down” means that as he was dying for us, he had the mixed emotions of love and sorrow at the same time. In the 4th verse, we see where Isaac Watts, the hymn writer, concludes that “love so amazing and divine demands our soul, our life, OUR ALL!
