

Family Worship

"Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth! I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old, things that we have heard and know, that our fathers have told us. We will not hide them from their children, but tell them to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might, and the wonders that he has done." Psalm 78:4



Parents, you have the joyful responsibility to teach the next generation the glorious deeds of the Lord. Use this list as a simple guide to help your family worship time.

- 1. Try to gather once a day as a family. Try to make it the same time and place every day.
- 2. It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- 3. Read scripture from the Bible, sing a song or two, pray. Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
- 4. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- 5. Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- 6. Additional options: read a devotion or Bible story book in addition to scripture, read through a particular book of the Bible and work your way through the entire Bible, take prayer request or take turns praying, review memory work and catechism questions.
- 7. Parents, pray this over your children:

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace. Numbers 6:24-26


First Choice Montgomery, Alabama

"Come Thou Fount of Every Blessing"

This hymn talks about the way all believers stray from God at times in their lives and how God is faithful to draw us back to Him. His mercy never ceases, and He continues to invite us back into His arms when we wander away from Him. In fact, Jesus pursued us when we were still sinners. Verse 2 says, "Jesus sought me when a stranger, wand'ring from the fold of God: He, to rescue me from danger, interposed His precious blood." To interpose means to come between. Jesus has come between you and your sin by cleansing you through the blood He shed on the cross. Isn't that amazing? We did nothing to deserve it, and even though we may try, we continue to do wrong, yet He continues to love us! What a wondrous blessing!

"O Love That Will Not Let Me Go"

This is a beautiful, poetic hymn about the love and promises of God. Verse 3 says, "I trace the rainbow through the rain and feel the promise is not vain." This verse is referring to a very specific passage of the Bible. Do you know what it is? When God flooded the earth after Noah built the ark, he made a covenant with Noah that He said would last forever. A covenant is a promise. God promised to never flood the earth like that again. The sign he gave was the rainbow. God said that He would remember the promise every time He saw the rainbow. We should, too! When you see a rainbow, remember that God's promises are true and that He will never break one of His promises! His love endures forever!
