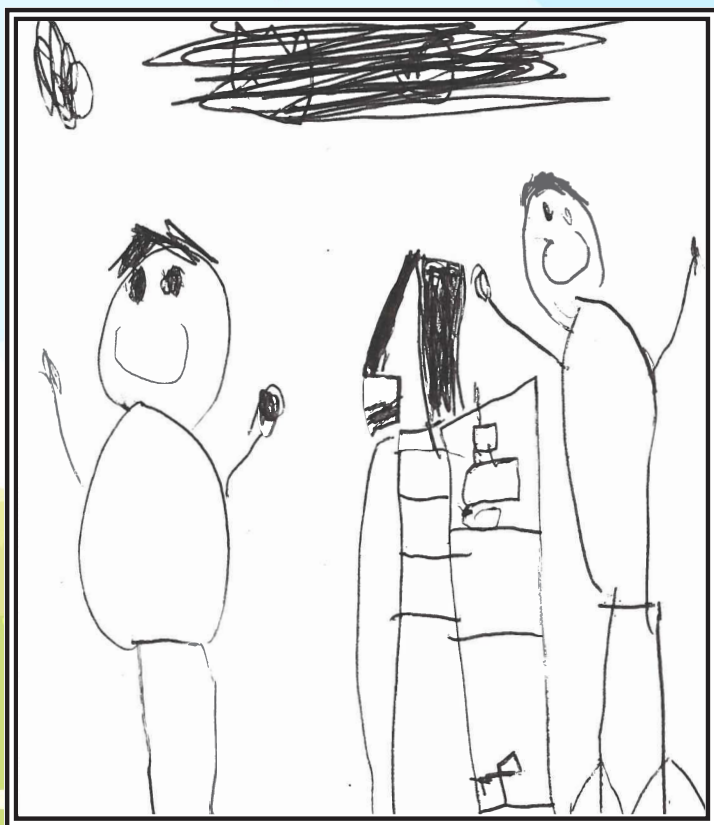

# A GUIDE TO *Family Worship*

*"Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth! I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old, things that we have heard and know, that our fathers have told us. We will not hide them from their children, but tell them to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might, and the wonders that he has done." Psalm 78:4*



Parents, you have the joyful responsibility to teach the next generation the glorious deeds of the Lord. Use this list as a simple guide to help your family worship time.

1. Try to gather once a day as a family. Try to make it the same time and place every day.
2. It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
3. Read scripture from the Bible, sing a song or two, pray. Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
4. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
5. Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
6. Additional options: read a devotion or Bible story book in addition to scripture, read through a particular book of the Bible and work your way through the entire Bible, take prayer request or take turns praying, review memory work and catechism questions.
7. Parents, pray this over your children:

*The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace. Numbers 6:24-26*

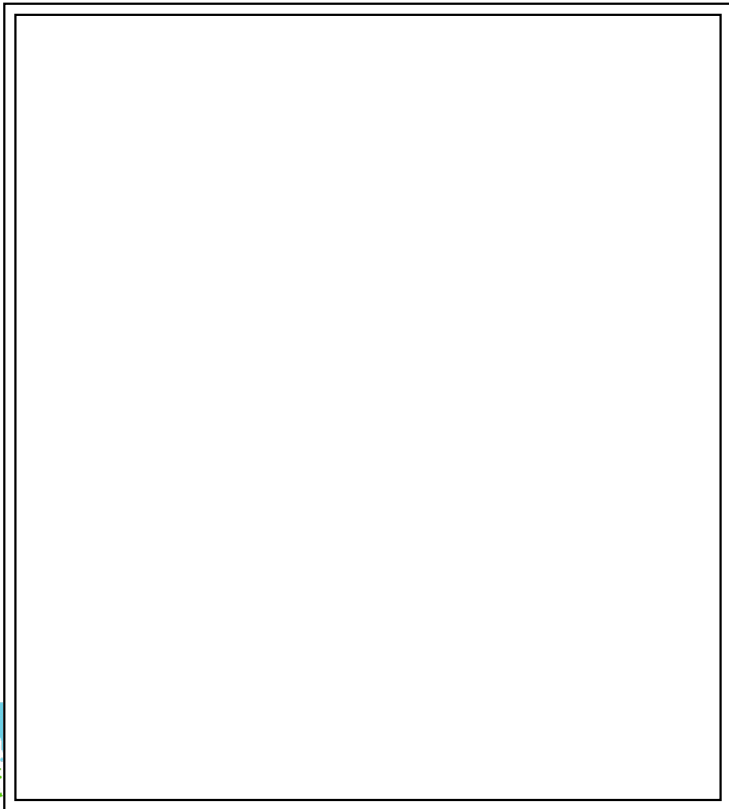
## **Kelley Herring** **Child Evangelism Fellowship • Montgomery, Alabama**

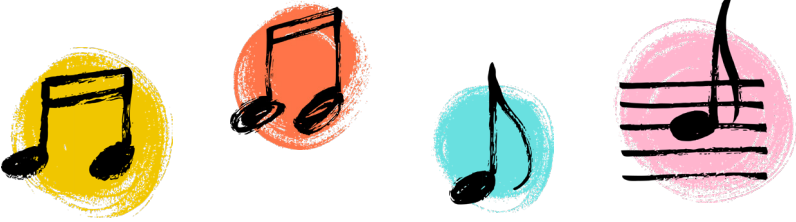

# Music and Hymns



## **“Rejoice, Ye Pure in Heart”**

If you believe in Jesus Christ, you are cleansed as white as snow, which makes you worthy of entering heaven's gates! This hymn says to “rejoice, give thanks, and sing” if you are pure in heart, because “at last the march shall end, the wearied ones shall rest; the pilgrims find their Father's house, Jerusalem the blest.” As believers in Jesus who have been cleansed, we will some day enter a house that Jesus has gone to prepare for us. In John 14:2, Jesus says, “In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I would go prepare a place for you?” Rejoice! Jesus is preparing a place for you!

## **“Jesus Paid It All”**

This hymn is about Jesus dying for our sins and paying for our sins even though we do not deserve it. The refrain proclaims, “Jesus paid it all, all to Him I owe; sin had left a crimson stain, and He washed it white as snow.” We are dirty and covered in sin, but God sees us as clean and holy because Jesus has cleansed us. Verse 3 says, “I'll wash my garments white in the blood of Calv'ry's Lamb.” Jesus was the final Passover lamb, the ultimate sacrifice. You are never too sinful for Jesus. No matter what you have done, He has the power to cleanse you and make you clean in the sight of God the Father.
