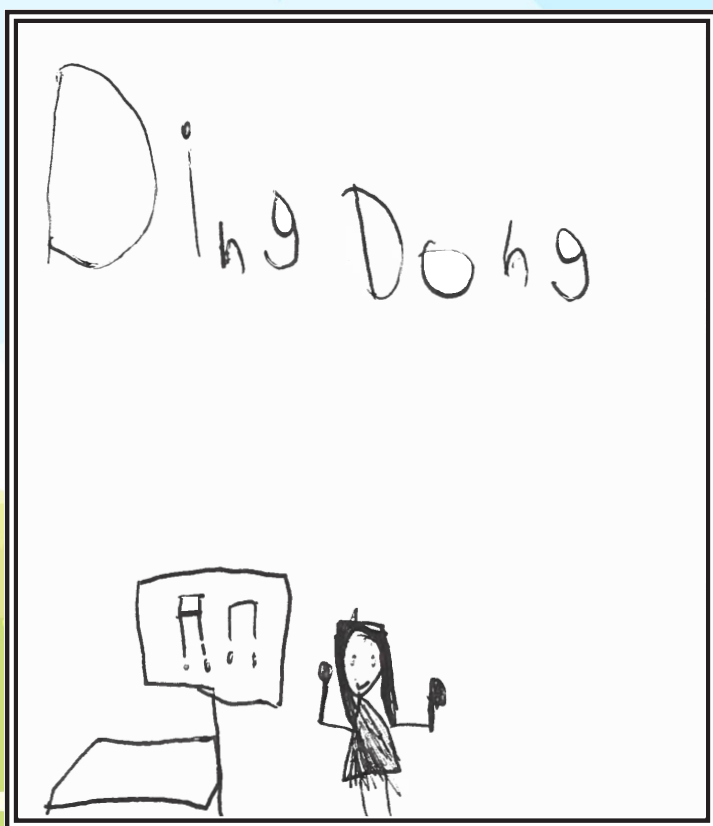

A GUIDE TO *Family Worship*

"Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth! I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old, things that we have heard and know, that our fathers have told us. We will not hide them from their children, but tell them to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might, and the wonders that he has done." Psalm 78:4



Parents, you have the joyful responsibility to teach the next generation the glorious deeds of the Lord. Use this list as a simple guide to help your family worship time.

1. Try to gather once a day as a family. Try to make it the same time and place every day.
2. It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
3. Read scripture from the Bible, sing a song or two, pray. Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
4. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
5. Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
6. Additional options: read a devotion or Bible story book in addition to scripture, read through a particular book of the Bible and work your way through the entire Bible, take prayer request or take turns praying, review memory work and catechism questions.
7. Parents, pray this over your children:

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace. Numbers 6:24-26

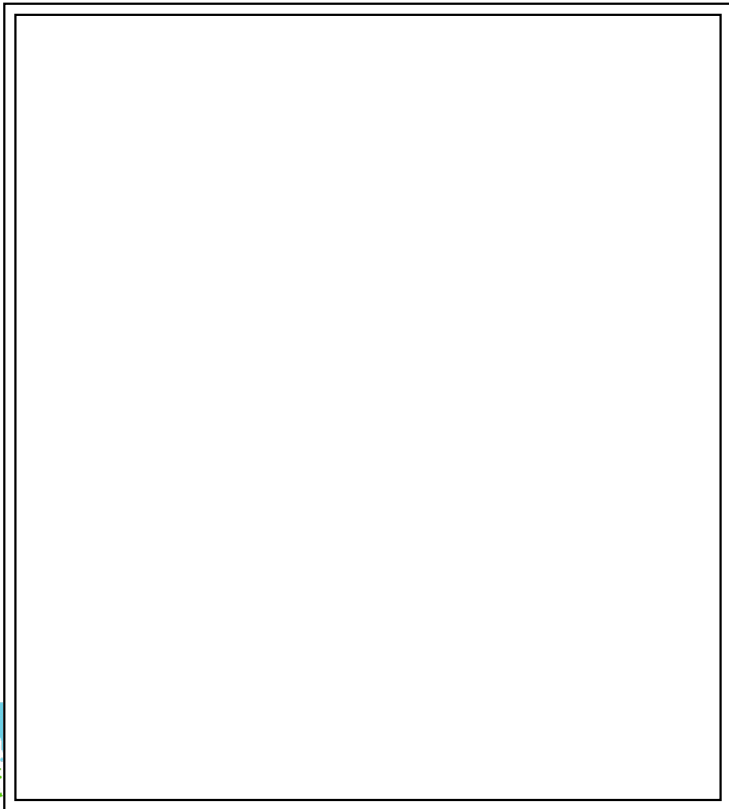
Benjamin and Missy Hatton

Benjamin and Missy are graduates of Ethnos360 Bible Institute and Missionary Training. They began their ministry as part of the training and coaching team that equips missionary candidates for missions. As the Lord worked in their lives, however, the Hattons made the switch to being overseas missionaries themselves in 2010. They have lived among the Amdu people in Papua New Guinea since 2012. A church was established in 2020. The Hattons continue to serve as church planters evangelizing the Amdu people, equipping the Amdu believers, and translating the Amdu Bible.

"My Jesus, I Love Thee"

Why do you love Jesus? The writer of this hymn says, "I love Thee because Thou has first loved me." Jesus loved you before you were even born. He came to earth and died on the cross for your sins because He loved you, even though you never asked Him to, even though we are all unworthy. He saved us from our sin, which we could never escape on our own. He prays for us and listens to us. Tell Jesus how much you love Him and thank Him for what He has done for you!

"Jesus, Thou Joy of Loving Hearts"

Verse 4 of this hymn really describes the gist of most of our prayers: "Make all our moments calm and bright; chase the dark night of sin away; shed o'er the world Thy holy light." We want God to make our lives calm, happy, and free of sin. This is what Jesus offers us through salvation by believing in Him.
