

Family Worship

"Give ear, O my people, to my teaching; incline your ears to the words of my mouth! I will open my mouth in a parable; I will utter dark sayings from of old, things that we have heard and know, that our fathers have told us. We will not hide them from their children, but tell them to the coming generation the glorious deeds of the LORD, and his might, and the wonders that he has done." Psalm 78:4



Parents, you have the joyful responsibility to teach the next generation the glorious deeds of the Lord. Use this list as a simple guide to help your family worship time.

- 1. Try to gather once a day as a family. Try to make it the same time and place every day.
- 2. It does not have to be long; it does not have to be perfect.
- 3. Read scripture from the Bible, sing a song or two, pray. Pray for the children; pray for missionaries; pray for Trinity Church; give thanks.
- 4. Everyone tell one thing they are thankful for.
- 5. Have a Leader of the Day: they get to read and/or pray and/or tell everyone to come gather and/or put out the Bibles/hymnals and/or tell something that happened to them that day.
- 6. Additional options: read a devotion or Bible story book in addition to scripture, read through a particular book of the Bible and work your way through the entire Bible, take prayer request or take turns praying, review memory work and catechism questions.
- 7. Parents, pray this over your children:

The LORD bless you and keep you; the LORD make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you the LORD lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace. Numbers 6:24-26


Brynn and Stuart Sims Ethnos360 Papua New Guinea

"Crown Him with Many Crowns"

Isn't it interesting to imagine a king crowned with not one but many crowns? Can you think how wonderful it would be if every one of us put a "crown" on Jesus by making him King in our own lives? We sing of the "Lamb upon his throne," the "Lord of Love," the "Lord of Peace," and the "Lord of Years." Verse 4 has some mighty big words!! Do you know that "Potentate" means the most high and powerful of Kings (King of Kings!)? The rolling spheres mean the planets in their orbits. And no matter what, praise of the almighty God will not fail, even if it looks like the forces of this world are winning.

"Here, O My Lord, I See Thee Face to Face"

This is a perfect hymn for communion. Most of you have probably not ever taken communion, but I am sure you have seen it and heard about it. We eat bread and drink grape juice that symbolize Jesus' body and blood shed on the cross for our sins. Taking communion is a very intimate moment with Jesus. Verse 4 says, "Mine is the sin, but Thine the righteousness; mine is the guilt, but Thine the cleansing blood." Communion is a reminder that Christ died for our sins, and we do it in remembrance of Him!
