Steve and Sherri are medical professionals who have been a part of the African church's hospital ministries in Zambia and Kenya for 27 years. They are passionate about equipping African healthcare professionals to share the love of Jesus in vulnerable communities.

Steve (MD, Internal Medicine/Pediatrics) now heads SIM's Banda Health ministry, which aims to see good healthcare and gospel-shaped hope within walking distance of the world's poorest patients. Banda uses innovative technology to extend the reach of medical missions, currently empowering 130 clinics caring for patients in African slums and villages and catalyzing ministry partnerships that help these communities address their overwhelming social and spiritual realities. Sherri (DPT) is a physical therapist currently involved in mentoring, governance, and trauma healing.
